- 6-9 I am unsatisfied with the pathway of my life and desire to take some shortcuts
- 10 Het **dissatisfaction** infect my life.

DIGGING INTO COMMAND #10

PAUL: I NEVER WOULD HAVE KNOWN // OUTLAWING DESIRE SEEMS IRRATIONAL // "DESIRE" WORDS CHAMAD: desire (often to possess), delight

IT'S SINFUL TO HAVE "STRONG DESIRE" FOR SOMEONE'S STUFF // WHERE'S THE LINE? // SEARS
NEARLY ALL DESIRES ARE DANGEROUS

DIG LEVEL 1:

desire => want => lack

ILL: WHEN I'M DISSATISFIED, I DO THE CRAZIEST THINGS LIKE EAT CANDY WHEN I'M THIRSTY

"The Want" is the symptom of me **m i s s i n g** something.

DIG LEVEL 2:

When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and **pleasing** [AVAH] to the eye, and also **desirable** [CHAMAD] for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it.

"The Want" puts me at **O d d s** with **G o d**.
