



**International Bioenergy Research and
Development Plan in Support of National Program Priorities**

BACKGROUND:

The Research, Education, and Economics (REE) Mission Area of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has Federal leadership responsibility to advance scientific knowledge regarding all aspects of agricultural science, to ensure and enhance the Nation's food, feed, fiber, and energy systems. The REE Mission Area encompasses four scientific agencies, Economic Research Service (ERS), National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS), Cooperative State Research, Education, and Extension Service (CSREES), and Agricultural Research Service (ARS).

ARS is the internal research arm of USDA and is directly responsible for solving problems of high national priority relating to agriculture. ARS maintains over 100 laboratories and field locations across the country and supports work by approximately 9000 scientists, engineers, and staff. Research and development of technologies to support the growth of renewable bio-based energy (bioenergy) is a high priority area for the agency. Bioenergy offers an attractive, renewable alternative to fossil fuel consumption and presents a tremendous opportunity for agriculture and rural communities.

ARS Office of International Research Programs (OIRP) recognizes the potential for bioenergy to help enhance domestic and international economics and is interested to expand international collaboration with research institutions to produce technologies and practices of mutual interest to support international economic development, trade capacity building, and increase export opportunities. OIRP, in partnership with USDA Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS), convened an international conference in Minneapolis, MN, in August 2007. The event drew international participants from nearly 40 countries and significantly increased the visibility of USDA leadership on a global level. The conference was supported by both the USDA REE Undersecretary and USDA Rural Development (RD) Undersecretary.

TASK OBJECTIVE:

OIRP requires specialized contractor support to develop a plan with the working title 'International Bioenergy Research and Development Strategic Plan in Support of National Program Priorities' as well as facilitate a roundtable discussion on the subject of 'International Bioenergy Research' with key relevant organizations in other agencies (e.g., Department of Energy, National Renewable Energy Laboratory).

SCOPE OF WORK:

The Contractor shall provide the Governmental with requisite subject matter expertise, relevant experience, and consulting skills required to achieve stated objectives, including:

- Establish criteria to identify and prioritize partnership opportunities for international bioenergy research and development appropriate for OIRP.
- Provide a high level of analytical expertise, including:
 - Conducting interviews with subject matter experts from Federal, State and private institutions
 - Review August international conference and other relevant materials,
 - Synthesize data from all available resources on the subject matter, including those of the USDA, other USG agencies and the contractor
- Facilitate interactions with other Federal departments and/or agencies to determine how Office of International Research Programs 'International Bioenergy Strategic Plan' can align with, support, and/or enhance these organizations

DELIVERABLES:

Contractor shall deliver:

- Draft of document with working title 'International Bioenergy Research and Development Strategic Plan in Support of National Program Priorities'. The document shall clearly identify and prioritize international partnerships opportunities with countries that are currently involved in bioenergy production and/or consumption.
- Summary presentation of the draft document
- Organize and provide materials for the Roundtable discussion, including a presentation in the Washington, DC metropolitan area.
- Summary presentation of the result of the Roundtable discussion


