- Despite his silence, God cares.
- Despite his patience, his actions are swift.
- When God sees a need, he moves a person. TRANSITION: MOSES AND AARON HAVE MOVED, WILL PHARAOH? WILL THE PEOPLE?

BEFORE PHARAOH (EX. 5:1-21)

READ THE WHOLE THING... WELL, THAT DIDN'T GO SO WELL!

Consider Pharaoh's Perspective

PERFECT EXAMPLE OF HOW SOME PEOPLE RESPOND TO CHANGE // EVEN A SMALL CHANGE 1. He doesn't know their God.

PHARAOH HAD A LOT OF GODS TO PAY ATTENTION TO... INCLUDING HIMSELF!

BUT THAT'S THE WRONG TEAM! Arrogant <u>I G N O R A N C E</u> can put you on the L O S I N G T E A M .

2. He's dealing with a lot of fear. VERSE 5, IF THEY HAVE TIME TO COMPLAIN, THEY HAVE TIME TO PLAN-- REVOLUTION ESPECIALLY SCARY IF HE IS ONE OF THE HYKSOS RULERS • SOLUTION: MORE WORK!!

Fear of losing **POWER** can make you **<u>CRUEL</u>**.

LANGUAGE, VIOLENCE, PASSIVE AGGRESSION

What about me? GP: EVER FACED A CHANGE / YOU DIDN'T BUY THE AUTHORITY / FEARED THE CONSEQUENCES?

Consider the Israelites

PUT YOURSELF IN THEIR SHOES... EXCITEMENT OVER MOSES' RETURN AND HIS WORDS

1. God disappointed them.

GOD SAID, I WILL SAVE YOU, BUT THE NEXT DAY IT ALL GOT WORSE! BOB SCHREIBER: BAPTISM \rightarrow CANCER \rightarrow SIMPLE HOPE \rightarrow HEALING!

God doesn't always **MAKE LIFE BETTER**.

2. Blame Moses and Aaron!

Disappointment leads us to **<u>LASH</u>OUT** at others.

What about me?

HAVE YOU EVER USED COMFORT TO MEASURE GOD'S INVOLVEMENT IN YOUR LIFE? HAVE YOU EVER LET DISAPPOINTMENT CAUSE YOU TO TURN ON OTHERS? ILL: MAN AT FIRST BAPTIST DIAGNOSED WITH M.S. -- NOT GETTING "FED" TRANSITION: BUT DON'T STOP THE STORY AT THE DISAPPOINTMENT! WATCH WHAT'S NEXT!!

BEFORE GOD (EX 5:22-6:8)

5:22-23 • MOSES HAS AN ASSET OTHERS DON'T HAVE... ACCESS TO GOD... HE USES IT! 6:1-8 • GOD DOESN'T ANSWER THE QUESTION...

God Reaffirms Three Things:

- God reaffirms his own **<u>CAPABILITY</u>**.
- God reaffirms his covenant **IDENTITY**.
- God reaffirms his **INTENTION**. IN DARKEST DAYS, WE CAN'T FORGET WHO GOD IS AND WHAT HE INTENDS TO DO.

TRANSITION: BUT MOSES HAD FORGOTTEN SOMETHING VERY IMPORTANT

WHAT MOSES FORGOT

Exodus 6:1...

Exodus 3:18-22...



You'll tell the elders, and they'll believe you.

- You'll ask the king of Egypt for three days off.
- He'll say no (until he's compelled).
- I will stretch out my hand.
 - He will be compelled to let you go.
 - They will send you away with wealth.

EVERYTHING IS GOING ACCORDING TO PLAN... LIVING IN THE GAP BETWEEN TWO CHECK BOXES.

TWO VERY IMPORTANT GOALS (LAST TWO) -- SOMEHOW THEIR HARDSHIP IS NECESSARY

God's good plan requires **DAYS** of **DARKNESS**.

TAKE IT HOME

Exodus 6:9-12...

- 1. Are you facing a time of change?
- 2. Has God somehow disappointed you?
- 3. Has God allowed some hardship into your life?
- 4. What have I forgotten about God?
