APOSTIE "sentone" Consistently in the NT, refers only to the first generation of church leaders. No instructions are given.

PROPHET "forth-teller" People who receive a special word from God for others. They are instructed to take turns and let others evaluate what they say.

"good news giver" Used only here, Philip, and Timothy No instructions are given.

PASTOR & TEACHER "shepherd" & teacher Only use of "shepherd" as a noun. Teacher is the only item in this list that has specific instructions for the future.

And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.

2 Timothy 2:2 NIV

The reason I left you in Crete was that you might put in order what was left unfinished and appoint elders in every town, as I directed you. An elder must be blameless, faithful to his wife, a man whose children believe and are not open to the charge of being wild and disobedient...

Since an overseer manages God's household, he must be blameless not overbearing, not quick-tempered, not given to drunkenness, not violent, not pursuing dishonest gain. Rather, he must be hospitable, one who loves what is good, who is self-controlled, upright, holy and disciplined...

He must hold firmly to the trustworthy message as it has been taught, so that he can encourage others by sound doctrine and refute those who oppose it.
