Columbia's Lamination Process

There are two problems in the manufacture of a phonograph record and strangely enough the two problems are diametrically opposed. These problems are (a) strength, (b) quictness and quality on the surface.

The type of materials which give a record trength are not those which make for a high putlity surface, and conversely the type of materials which give a high quality outface are those which true for make a reveal weak and brittle.
