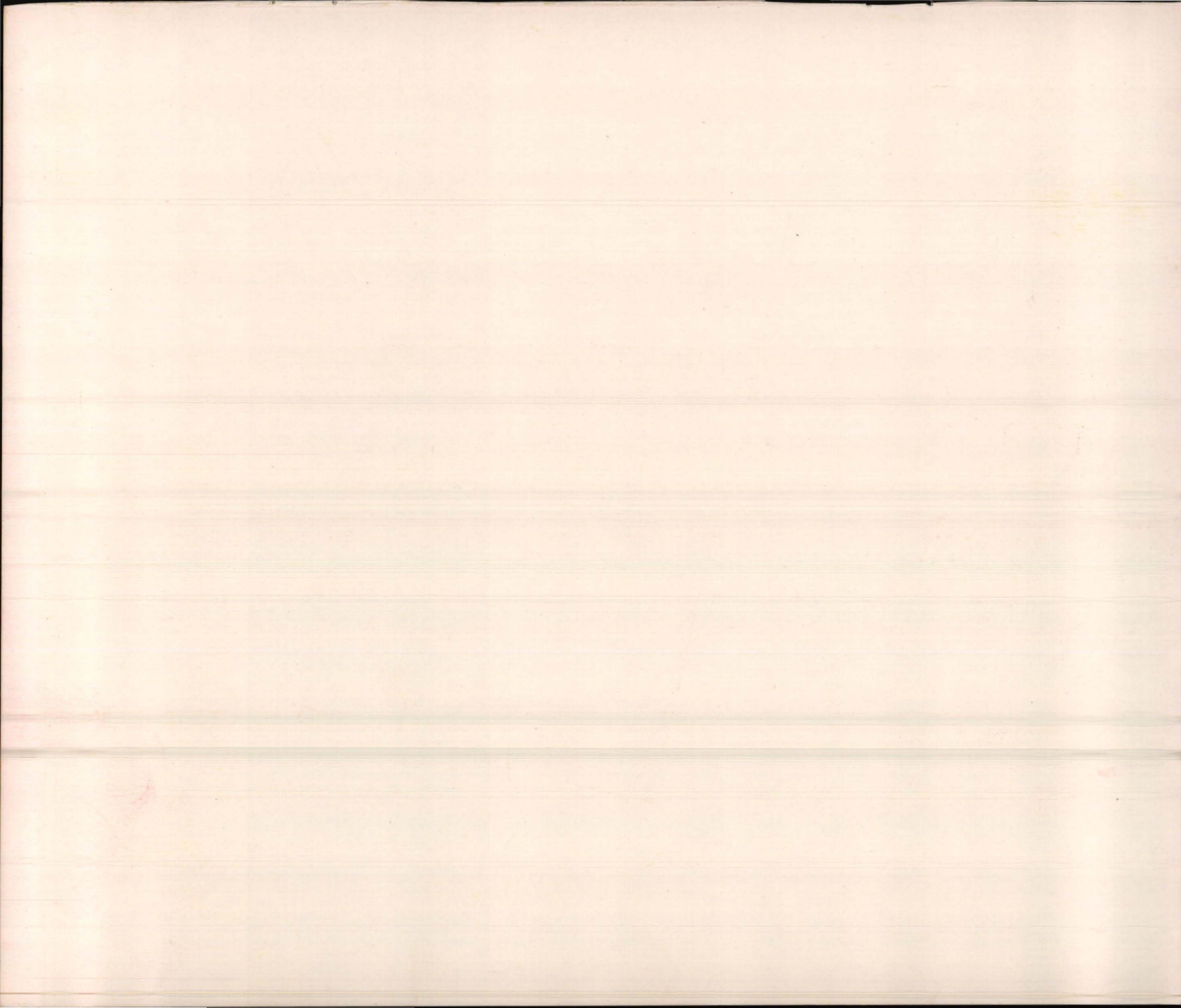

Hadeeth one

Salaam

إِنَّ أَوْلَى النَّاسِ بِاللَّهِ تَعَالَى مَنْ بَدَأَهُمْ بِالسَّلَامِ

as-salaamu
'alaikum

Indeed the nearest to Allaah
are those who make salaam
first

(Ahmad, Tirmizee, Abu Dawood)

KEYPOINTS:

- A Muslims greeting is a prayer of peace. Salaam creates love among Muslims.
- Do not wait for others to greet you. Always try to be the first to greet.

INTRODUCTION TO *HADEETH*

Allaah ﷻ revealed the Qur'aan to *Nabee* Muhammad ﷺ and instructed him to explain it to us. *Nabee* Muhammad ﷺ accordingly explained and showed us the manner of acting upon the Qur'aan. His words and actions are termed as "A^HA^A DEETH" (Single – *hadeeth*) Allaah ﷻ has ordered us in the Qur'aan to obey *Rasoolullah* ﷺ. The only way to obey him is to know *Ahaadeeth*. Refusal to believe in, or act upon *Ahaadeeth* amounts to refusal to believe in, and act upon the Commands of Allaah and the words of *Rasoolullah* ﷺ. This leads one out of the fold of Islaam.

Many books have been written, which contain detailed actions and words of *Rasoolullah* ﷺ Bukhaaree, Muslim, and Tirmizee are some of the famous works of *Ahadeeth*. Besides these works many great scholars have also memorized the words of *Ahadeeth*. There is great virtue in memorizing *Ahaadeeth*. Memorizing *Ahaadeeth* helps preserve the teachings of *Rasoolullah* ﷺ. *Nabee* ﷺ made the following *du'a* for those who memorize his words:

نَضَّرَ اللّٰهُ اِمْرًا سَمِعَ مِنَّا شَيْئًا فَبَلَّغَهُ كَمَا سَمِعَهُ

May Allaah Ta'ala flourish a person who hears something from us then conveys it exactly as he heard it – Tirmizee

He also said:

مَنْ حَفِظَ عَلَيَّ اُمَّتِيْ اَرْبَعِيْنَ حَدِيْثًا مِنْ سُنَّتِيْ
اَدْخَلْتُهُ يَوْمَ الْقِيَامَةِ فِيْ شَفَاعَتِيْ

He who preserves (memorizes) for my followers 40 Ahaadeeth from my teachings; I will admit him on the Day of Judgement in my intercession (before Allaah)

It is therefore a great honour to be able to memorize the very words spoken by our beloved *Nabee*. We should make an effort to practice every teaching of his as recorded in the *Ahaadeeth*.

Note: The key points are to enhance the lesson. Learners should not be made to memorize them.

KEYPOINTS:

Primary purpose of teaching *Ahaadeeth* from class one to seven is:

1. To memorise the *Ahaadeeth*
2. To encourage practice
3. To develop a desire to earn reward (Thawaab).

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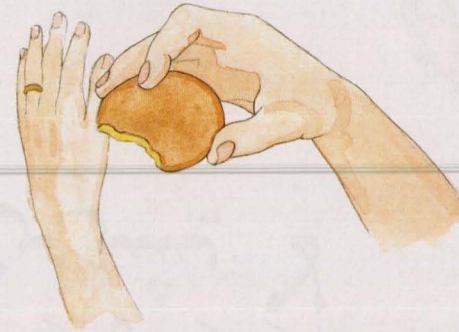
Hadeeth two

KEYPOINTS:

- Do not eat with your left hand.
We use our left hand to make Istinjaa`.
- Always take the name of Allaah before eating.
Shaytaan shares the food of those who eat
without taking the name of Allaah.

Hadeeth three

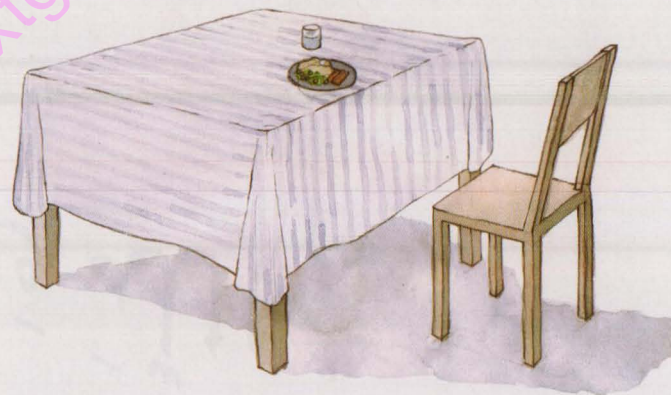


Drinking

لَا يَشْرِبُ أَحَدٌ مِنْكُمْ قَائِمًا

None of you should stand
and drink

(Muslim)



KEYPOINTS:

- We do not follow the habits of proud people.
- We always thank Allaah for His favours and show our humbleness.
- Animals stand while eating and drinking.

Hadeeth four

Mother

الْجَنَّةُ تَحْتَ أَقْدَامِ الْأُمَّهَاتِ

Paradise lies under
the feet of mothers

(Kanzul Ummaal)



KEYPOINTS:

- Our mothers take care of us with so much difficulty and pain.
- We can never repay them for their love and kindness.
- If we obey and respect them, we will enter Jannah. Allaah is pleased with those who serve their parents.

Hadeeth five

Truthfulness

عَلَيْكُمْ بِالصِّدْقِ

(Always) be truthful

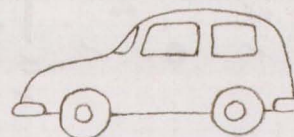

KEYPOINTS:

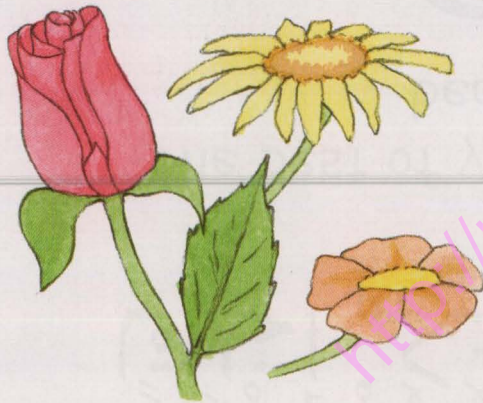
• Muslims do not speak lies nor do they break their promises.

Character

إِنَّ مِنْ خَيْرِكُمْ أَحْسَنُكُمْ أَخْلَاقًا

The best of you are those with the most beautiful character

(Bukhaaree)

elderly and disabled

KEYPOINTS:

- Beautify your character:
 - Show mercy to the young and respect to the elders.
 - Be honest and caring.
 - Be obedient and hardworking.

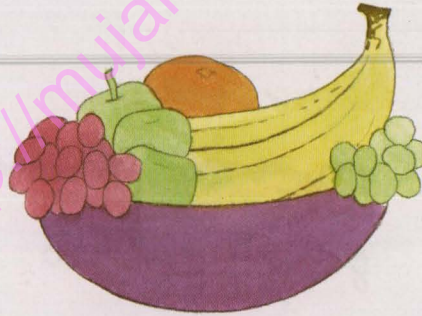
Hadeeth eight

(Ahmad & Tirmizee)



KEYPOINTS:

- A true believer takes care of his neighbours.
- He feeds them when they are hungry.
- He visits them when they are sick.
- He does not harm them or hurt their feelings.

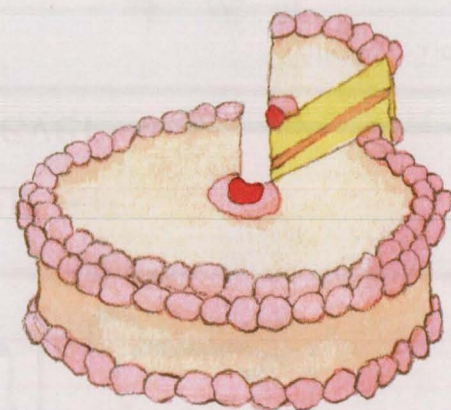
Sharing

• We are all brothers and sisters of one big family.

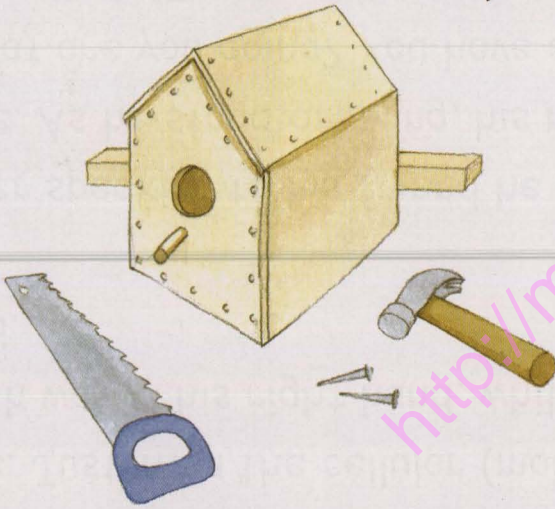
- Muslims are not selfish people.
