The people of Thamud were amazed to see the power of Allah, but even then they refused to believe. They said the miracle was a spell and


Prophet Salih was a magician.



The She-Camel was very large and unusual in form. She loitered here and there and wherever she went to drink or graze grass in any jungle all the Cattle were frightened and ran away.


