Mr. SCHRANK introduced the following Citizen Action on behalf of himself, and the Statutory Thection, which was scheduled by said Thection for consideration by the Citizen Thection on the same day.

A Citizen Action

To establish official parameters of Citizen Actions.

- (1) A Citizen Action is a piece of legislation voted on by the Citizen Thection.
- (2) A Citizen Action document such as this is not absolutely necessary to have before voting occurs

on a particular issue, however one shall always be drafted and published after the vote by the Statutory Thection.

(3) Anyone, especially voting members of the Citizen Thection, are then invited to file a motion to contest a variation in the Citizen Action document from the previously agreed upon resolution.

(4) Another vote may occur if necessary after a document has been drafted.

(5) Once a final action has been approved by the Citizen Thection, and validated for constitutionality by the Statutory Thection, it is sent to the desk of the president to be signed, after which the Citizen Action takes effect.

(6) If the president refuses to sign, the Supreme Justice has the ultimate authority to sign it. If he or she refuses to sign, then it is sent back to the Citizen Thection where it will then require three-fourths of the voting members' support.

(7) All Citizen Actions should be publicly available, and if possible made so before voting occurs. If at all possible, voting members' votes shall also be publicly available. Making them available to the Institute of

Thagian Law is preferable.

(8) It is affirmed that a Citizen Action may be fully or partially repealed in one of two ways. One, it could be repealed in a universal veto by a popular vote proposed by citizens. Two, it can be found unconstitutional by a future Statutory Thection.
