I) GOD'S DIFFICULTY: ABSOLUTELY NOTHING! (Jonah 2:10)

II) JONAH'S DIFFICULTY: ANNOUNCING TO NINEVAH? (Jonah 3:1-4) How To Respond To The Clear Commands Of God
1) Regardless of how we may feel inside, we mustTRUST AND OBEY God's commands. (v.1-3a)
2) Regardless of how much effort is needed, we mustFULFILL God's work. (v.3b)
3) Regardless of how daunting the challenge, we mustCOMMUNICATE God's message. (v.4)
III) NINEVAH'S DIFFICULTY: ACKNOWLEDGING SIN! (Jonah 3:5-10) How To React To Our Open Offenses Toward God
1) When God convicts us, weACKNOWLEDGE IT IMMEDIATELY (v.5)
2) When sin confronts us, weABHOR IT COMPLETELY (v.6)
3) When repentance calls us, weACT ON IT PERSONALLY (v.7-9)
4) When God sees serious contrition in us, weARE SPARED FROM DIRE CONSEQUENCES (v.10)
IV) OUR DIFFICULTY: WILL WE DO WHAT GOD WANTS? (Application)
1) Obeying God isn't always easy, but disobeying Him isALWAYS HARDER
2) Disobeying God is inevitable, but how long we disobey Him isOPTIONAL
