SECRET AGENT



I was Lieutenant Commander with the Israeli Navy, and given that I'm of Canadian origin, I spoke English fairly well. I was also willing to do anything I was asked, so they asked me to join and I agreed. Basically, they sean through the military records, and there's a series of flags that come up as you progress through your eareer and gain various skills. It's hard to say what those flags are, but when the required number show on your record, they'll ask you in, interview you, test you, and ask if you want to work for the security of your country. They don't mention the name of the agency, of course - you just kind of know what you're getting into.

We've read that a Mossad cadet will experience more action, more pure terror and more physical assault during training than many Special Forces operatives will in the course of an entire career, so what's the training regime actually like? I'd say that's fairly accurate. I trained for 17 months, and in that time, I trained with Special Forces - Israeli Navy Scals, specifically. I had to do everything they did. The difference between the two is that when you go on a mission with Special Forces, you have an exit strategy. When you're doing this kind of work for Mossad, you don't have that. You can't plan. It's part of combat to attack and fire and be shot at. Agreed, it's seary, but you're typically marching on an enemy with a unit and you're armed and you know what's coming. When you're doing my kind of work, you're on the edge there's no rope, there's no safety net. If you get taken in and questioned, you're by yourself. It's complete vulnerability.

And were you ever caught?

I was never exposed. I don't think any Mossad guy has ever fallen. But I did have a nail pulled out by the Jordanian intelligence service, and it was no fun. First, they put a little injection of air under the nail, and it starts to separate the flesh away from underneath. It's exeruciatingly painful, and it flips your nail upwards. That's when they begin playing with it. It sounds like a little thing, but the threat's explicit – once we're done with this one, we're on to the next, and the next. What was going through my mind was if I admit to



anything, they're only going to go further. So, I just had to convince them that they were wrong, that they had the wrong guy, and to make them feel bad about what they were doing. Yeah, I was crying and screaming, but it wasn't as if they were playing with my d*ck!

In the movie *The Debt*, the Mossad agents lead a pretty intense life. What was everyday life like for you?

I was an attack-ease officer, and this would involve recruiting targets and getting information from them. So, let's say a suitable target might be an Air Force Liaison Officer from the Syrian embassy in London. First, there would be a huge intelligence gathering operation, during which time we'd work out his routine. Then we'd bug his house and find out how he thought and how he worked, and this would provide us with his "hook". People are generally motivated by one of three hooks - greed, revenge or sex - and once you've worked out what that is, you can make your approach.

What happens next?

The trick is to get them to make the first move, so if they ever think back to when they first met you, they'll think it was their idea. So, you and another agent would sit either side of your target at a bar and have a conversation with each other, mentioning points of interest that you know are irresistible to your mark. He'll soon join in. We had one guy who was mad about chess, and we placed an agent in his hotel lobby day after day playing chess with himself. The guy walked past countless times before he said, "Can I make a suggestion?" After that, we had him.

Who would you recruit?

For a start, I should explain that everybody's recruitable. You could sell out your own country to me and you wouldn't even know you're doing it. We'd recruit all sorts of people from surprising places – nurses, delivery workers, even laundry guys. If a country's going to war, say, there are things that need to happen first – hospital beds need to be emptied, bandages need to be stockpiled – and we need to know if this is happening. If it's not, but our embassy officer contact says otherwise, we know he's talking bullsh*t.


How many aliases did you have?

Plenty, although I never said I was a dentist. Say that and everyone on the planet wants to show you their mouth!

What's the closest you've come to death?

There was a guy in Jordan who put a gun to my head and said, "We know your game." Funnily enough, the first thought that went through my head was that the gun wasn't cold like they said it would be in books! And then I noticed that this guy was on my right, and yet his second in command was on my left. If he was going to shoot me, he was going to shoot his buddy too, so I kind of knew he was bluffing. I never did fear for my life, come to think of it. As the saying goes, "The coward dies a thousand times, but the brave guy dies only onee."

Hi Mario! Is it fair to say you're one of the most notorious

Premier League players? This reputation comes from the newspapers. There's exaggeration in much of what the English press say. If you believed everything, you'd think I'm a monster.

So, what's the truth?

I'm a young man who makes mistakes sometimes. I came here from another country and have found myself lonely at times. But I'm not a erazy person!

Are you homesick?

Yes, I've missed my home, but I think I've done well. I hear people think I'm always angry. This isn't true. I like to laugh, joke, be happy – ask my team-mates. On the pitch, I'm smiling inside even if I don't show it. Maybe I'm a good actor!

How do you cope with being the centre of attention?

It's not casy. I'm a private person and don't like the games that come with being in focus all the time. There are untruths that come from pcople who I've never even met or spoken to. I'm no angel, but this situation is a problem.

What do you do to unwind? I stay at home and play vidco games. Then I may go out and eat or do some shopping. All very boring! Any truth in the rumours you'd like to return to Italy? Rumours may sell papers but rumours are not truth. I'm under contract with Manchester and this is the end of the matter. This is a club with huge ambition, and I'm ambitious, too.

What's City boss Roberto Mancini like to work for?

All players require a coach who knows how to get everything out of the team, but also individuals. We have this here. For me, he's been incredible. He's the most important coach in my career. If there was another manager, I wouldn't be here.

How good can City become?

I have faith in this group. We have the players to win the league this season and become the top side in Europe. This isn't about trying to sound big – it's what I believe in my heart.

And can we expect more bonkers Mario Balotelli headlines in the future? I hope not! If I did the things people say, I'd be crazy, but I'm not. I'm normal and maybe people will speak about me for the football rather than the other things. I believe I can be one of the best players if I work hard. I have to believe it'll happen. Maybe people will soon write about Mario the footballer rather than Mario the mad man!

Whethcr it was my style of play or just something about how I carried myself, some managers didn't fancy me. Maybe it was because as a younger man I was a worrier. I've grown in confidence, which has come from playing well last season. Getting the [Football Writers'] award also hclped – so too being involved with England.

It's been a turnaround. you're now a mainstay for England!

I've been in and around England squads for years, but could never seem to get over that last hurdle. I've finally done it and now believe I belong as an England player.

Can you maintain your all-action style of play?

Too much is made of age, I reekon. The game has moved on in terms of fitness, nutrition and how players look after themselves, so you can extend your career.

Can you play on beyond this four-year contract? Why not? I've improved season by season and now I'm playing my best football.

Any thoughts on how England will get on in Euro 2012 this summer? I can't wait! It'll be my first tournament, if selected. We

tournament, if selected. We know it'll be tough, but whatever happens, I'll be proud to represent my country, like I always am!


