Nat Bates has been performing as an experimental musician and sound artist for a number of years, most notably at Sonic Residues 02 - ACCA (2000), Electrofringe - Newcastle (2001) and the What Is Music? Festival (2001). His current project, M A C H I N A, explores the genre of 'ROCK' and will result in an album supported by Arts Victoria. The project has bloomed into an improvised performance collaboration with Stephen Masterson on drums and Nat performing electronic manipulations of electric guitar and bass textures.
