The team advanced to the quarter finals in which they played Cannan and won with a score of 1-0. They then went on to the semi-finals to play Stowe, where they lost.

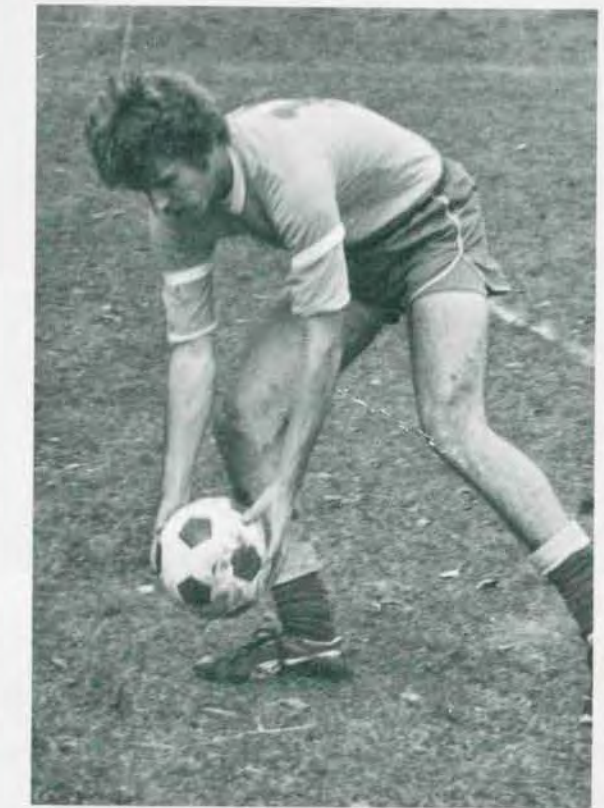
