

#### Louisiana Conference United Methodist Women President's Report 2008

The mission area of SOCIAL ACTION is focused on improving the social, economic, environmental and/or political conditions that affect women and children.

Each Social Action Coordinator in the local church provides leadership by addressing one or more social action conditions (as above). By doing so, the unit is eligible to receive the "EXEMPLARY SERVICE AWARD IN SOCIAL ACTION". Examples of activities that qualify as social action activities are:

Study groups on world peace; advocating for the "No Child Left Behind" moral concerns; services to the poor and needy in your community; improving the conditions for disadvantaged children and/or women; promoting women to positions of leadership in the church and community; helping with environmental concerns.

Of the four Social Action areas: (1) social, (2) economic, (3) environmental and (4) political, the first area has been highlighted for an additional certificate. In the first area, a focus on 'racial harmony and action' will earn for the unit the certificate of "Charter School for Racial Justice Recognition Certificate". To receive this certificate, each local unit must satisfy the criteria as specified on the form.

Greetings and Blessings to all in attendance at the 2008 Annual Meeting of the Louisiana Conference
United Methodist Women

The office of Communications Coordinator has provided me a lot of "on the job training", and I hope it will be a continued learning and retention process. Many thanks to our immediate past Coordinator of Communications, Mary Quinones who traveled from her new home in Texas after hurricane Katrina to our 2007 DELT event and combined that trip to review with me the specifics of the Communications officer processes and responsibilities. Through her foresight and hard work, the foundation was laid for use of our conference newspaper as a medium for highlighting our activities and spreading our news. Special thanks also are extended to Betty Backstrom, Editor of our LA Now newspaper and to Sally Davidson, Communications Assistant for the Louisiana Conference UM Church.

We appreciate the enthusiasm that you, the reporters, have had in submitting information for our conference newsletter. Even though there are sometimes delays with the inclusion of news from the districts because of limited space during our highlighted conference and jurisdiction events. Please don't be discouraged and continue to send news of what you are doing...It's Our Mission.

Let me share some of the information on our UMW paper:

- 1. The UMW insert is published four times/year in the LA NOW:
  - January Newsletter- Articles/News due November 20th
  - May Newsletter Articles/News due March 26th
  - August Newsletter- Articles/News due July 9th
  - November Newsletter Articles/News due October 8<sup>th</sup>
  - Our next UMW insert will be in the LA Now dated November 21, 2008.
- 2. The plan is for our section of the paper to be an insert so that it can be a "lift-out" section for easy distribution.
- 3. Cost/charges have remained @ \$1,500/issue (\$375/page); \$6,000/year
- 4. Contact with the Communications Office for the Louisiana Conference UMC informs us that the *LA Now* has a mailing of 4,630+ and with recent increases is distribution sites, there is an estimated total of 5,700 copies distributed.

New /additional distribution sites are:

Disaster Response Centers-500 copies each. These sites include New Orleans, Dulac, Abbeville, and Lake Charles.

Just added is another 500 copies to churches.

An additional site is the Wesley Center.

All pastors and D.S.'s, active & retired, get copies as do surviving spouses.

#### Communications Coordinator Report, cont'd

Currently the UMW mailing list consists of 759 persons. Sally monitors these lists for duplications between the UMW listing and the Louisiana conference office listing. Duplications are eliminated this way.

The readership with UMW can be increased by offering a separate mailing list specific for UMW. Per info from the communications assistant, this would be a mailing of the specific four issues which include UMW news. The cost would be approximately \$1.00/person. If you know of someone who would be appropriate for such a mailing, please let us know.

A subscription Drive was done early this year and was quite successful. Subscription charges are \$20/year and \$30/2 year subscription. (subscription form is attached)

Our most recent issue was dated July 25<sup>th</sup>. This date was an earlier date for us than last year's paper which was published in August. This July issue was implemented in an effort to get as much of our voting info out in a timely manner.
