FOUR SECTION COURSE FOR CERTIFICATE IN INDUSTRIAL MANAGEMENT

C. I. M.

(CIMA Certificate by Charter of the Department of Education Province of Ontario)

The Department of University Extension, University of Toronto, in co-operation with the Canadian Industrial Management Association, Toronto Branch, will offer during the 1957-58 session, Sections I and II of a four Section Course designed to meet the examination requirements of the C.I.M.A. Certificate in Industrial Management and Administration.

Designed to give an authoritative and comprehensive coverage in subjects relating to industrial management, the Course (Four Sections) leads to a certificate standing of recognized value throughout Ontario. The Education Advisory Committee composed of representatives from Universities and qualified industrial experts, have given guidance to the leading University authorities in the field of Business Administration who have designed the Course.

Each Section represents one academic year's work made up of 24 two-hour lecture-discussion periods and examinations. The Courses for the four years are:

- Section I Production Organization and Planning
- Section II Industrial Engineering and Industrial Relations
- Section III Accounting—Finance—Marketing
- Section IV Administrative Practices and Problems

Sections I and II will be the only ones given in the Toronto Area during the academic year 1957-58.
