ADMINISTRATION

Services Provided. Issuing of occupational licenses, personal and shop, inspections of new shops, etc.

Objectives. To have all barber shops equipped with proper sanitation equipment and each barber have a current health certificate.

Achievements. During this last licensing period, no practical barber was given a license without first submitting a health certificate. Members of the Board have tried as far as possible to cover all shops to check on proper sanitation practices.
