Standard Interpretation:

Jesus is showing her **LOVE** in spite of her **SIN**.

BUT SHE IS LIKELY THE VICTIM, THE STORY NEVER MENTIONS LOVE, SIN, OR FORGIVENESS 4:15 • SELFISH? (GO GET SOMEONE ELSE)

Alternative Interpretation:

She couldn't receive the living water

<u>BYHERSELF, FORHERSELF</u>.
