He changed plans to not return and WROTE a LETTER instead.



The letter WORKED, but division PERSISTS.





2 CORINTHIANS 1:17-22

People will let you down, but the TRIUNE GOD never will.





But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere...

For we are the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing, to one a fragrance from death to death, to the other a fragrance from life to life. Who is sufficient for these things?



My aroma is **SACRIFICE**. My sacrifice is **TRIUMPH**!



Then Noah built an altar to the LORD and, taking some of all the clean animals and clean birds, he sacrificed bumt offenngs on it. The LORD smelled the pleasing aroma and said in his heart "Never again will curse the ground because of humans...

Genesis 8:20-21 NIV

"Take one of the rams, and Aaron and his sons shall lay their hands on its head. Slaughter it and take the blood and splash it against the sides of the altar.
