Claim Your Promise

Read **Joshua 13:1**. How do you feel when you have been working on a project for a very long time and realize there is still a lot of work left to do?

Read **Joshua 14:1-5**. These verses summarize everything that happens from chapters 13-22. Since Joshua is “well advanced” in years, God tells Joshua to delegate the rest of the conquest to all the people, tribe by tribe. Each tribe is now responsible to claim their own territory and cleanse their land.

Read **Joshua 14:6-15**. What do you think of Caleb here?

What gave Caleb the confidence that he could fight the giant Anakites?

*This is the way God worked with the Israelites. He made promises, and he brought his people to those promises, but then he gave them the work of **claiming** those promises by stepping into them in faith. When we look into the New Testament, we see the same principle. Jesus makes promises and asks us to step into them.*
