RUTH 3:1-4 • THIS IS A BIG RISK... FOR RUTH! • HOW GOOD OF A MAN IS BOAZ?

Ruth's Part of the Plan

5-9 • SHE ADDED SOMETHING IMPORTANT • GARMENT = KANAP = WING • SEE 2:12 • EZEKIEL 16:8
SHE TELLS BOAZ HE IS GOD'S COVERING FOR HER • AND IT'S A PROPOSAL... BUT A RISKY ONE!

Ruth took a RISK to PROPOSE to Boaz.

BUT IT'S ALSO RISKY • PULLING BACK THE BLANKET FROM A MAN WHO HAD BEEN DRINKING!
BUT HE IS A GOOD MAN • 10-15 • HE DEFENDS HER HONOR • 16-18 • [NAOMI'S EMPTINESS IS ENDING]

Boaz's Part of the Plan

DOING THE RIGHT THING WOULD BE RISKY • 4:1-4 • PLAN A, ADDRESS THE LAND REDEMPTION 5-8 • PLAN B, REMIND THE MAN ABOUT RUTH AND THE DEAD MAN'S NAME • 9-10

Boaz took a RISK to do what's RIGHT.

AND IT WORKED OUT! • 11-12 • PEREZ? • TAMAR → ER → ONAN → SHELAH? → JUDAH!

TAMAR: A DISGRACED, REJECTED WIDOW WHO IS OUR ANCESTOR!

God's Even Better Plan

13-16 • GOD GAVE HER A CHILD DESPITE BARRENNESS • GOD BROUGHT REDEMPTION TO NAOM!

God **R E D E E M E D** this little family!

BUT, THE BOOK ISN'T OVER... 17

God redeemed the WHOLENATION!

18-22 • 10 NAMES... ONE FOR EVERY YEAR IN MOAB, BUT EVEN MORE • MT 1:3-6, 16

God redeemed the WHOLEWORLD!

Boaz's Part of the Plan

DOING THE RIGHT THING WOULD BE RISKY • 4:1-4 • PLAN A, ADDRESS THE LAND REDEMPTION
5-8 • PLAN B, REMIND THE MAN ABOUT RUTH AND THE DEAD MAN'S NAME • 9-10

Boaz took a RISK to do what's RIGHT.

AND IT WORKED OUT! • 11-12 • PEREZ? • TAMAR \to ER \to ONAN \to SHELAH? \to JUDAH! TAMAR: A DISGRACED, REJECTED WIDOW WHO IS OUR ANCESTOR!

God's Even Better Plan

13-16 • GOD GAVE HER A CHILD DESPITE BARRENNESS • GOD BROUGHT REDEMPTION TO NAOM!

God **REDEEMED** this little family!

BUT, THE BOOK ISN'T OVER... 17

God redeemed the WHOLENATION!

18-22 • 10 NAMES... ONE FOR EVERY YEAR IN MOAB, BUT EVEN MORE • MT 1:3-6, 16
