## The Mission: Matthew 28:16-20

Read **Matthew 28:10 & 16**. After his resurrection, Jesus said he would meet the disciples in Galilee. Why not right there in Jerusalem?

On Sunday, I noted that God often requires his people to go on a journey promising to meet them at the other end. What Old Testament examples can you think of to illustrate this? Why do you think God does that?

How do you deal with being in “the middle” of a journey?

*I think one reason Jesus has the disciples go on the journey to Galilee is to prepare them in principle for the Great Commission. They go on the journey, and when the get there, he meets them with an affirmation of his authority.*

Read **Matthew 28:18**. What does it mean to you that Jesus has all the authority in the universe?

Is there some aspect of your life or our world today where it feels to you like his authority is limited? How do you deal with that?

Read **Philippians 2:5-11**. What does that passage say about the authority of Jesus?

The authority of Jesus vividly represents the way God’s power always works. The way I phrased it on Sunday was this: **FROM GOD, FOR OTHERS.**

What does that phrase mean to you?

Read **Matthew 28:19-20**. How is the Great Commission speaking to you today? Is it calling you to do something new or differently?
