H. Martyn over said Church & the Society connected with it, & which Council after its second session in Jan^y last adjourned sine die - requesting that said Council may be again convened to take into consideration certain reports relating to transactions said to have transpired after said Martyn had received a call to settle & before the final ^{or during the time of his preaching in Haverhill} session of the Council, but not then known to them, unfavorable to his moral & ministerial character & act thereon, it has been concluded to invite the members of the Council to assemble in the Vestry of said Church on Tuesday the 21st inst 9 o'clock A.M. to act on the premises. This therefore is to notify you & your delegate of the meeting & to request your attendance at that time & place.
