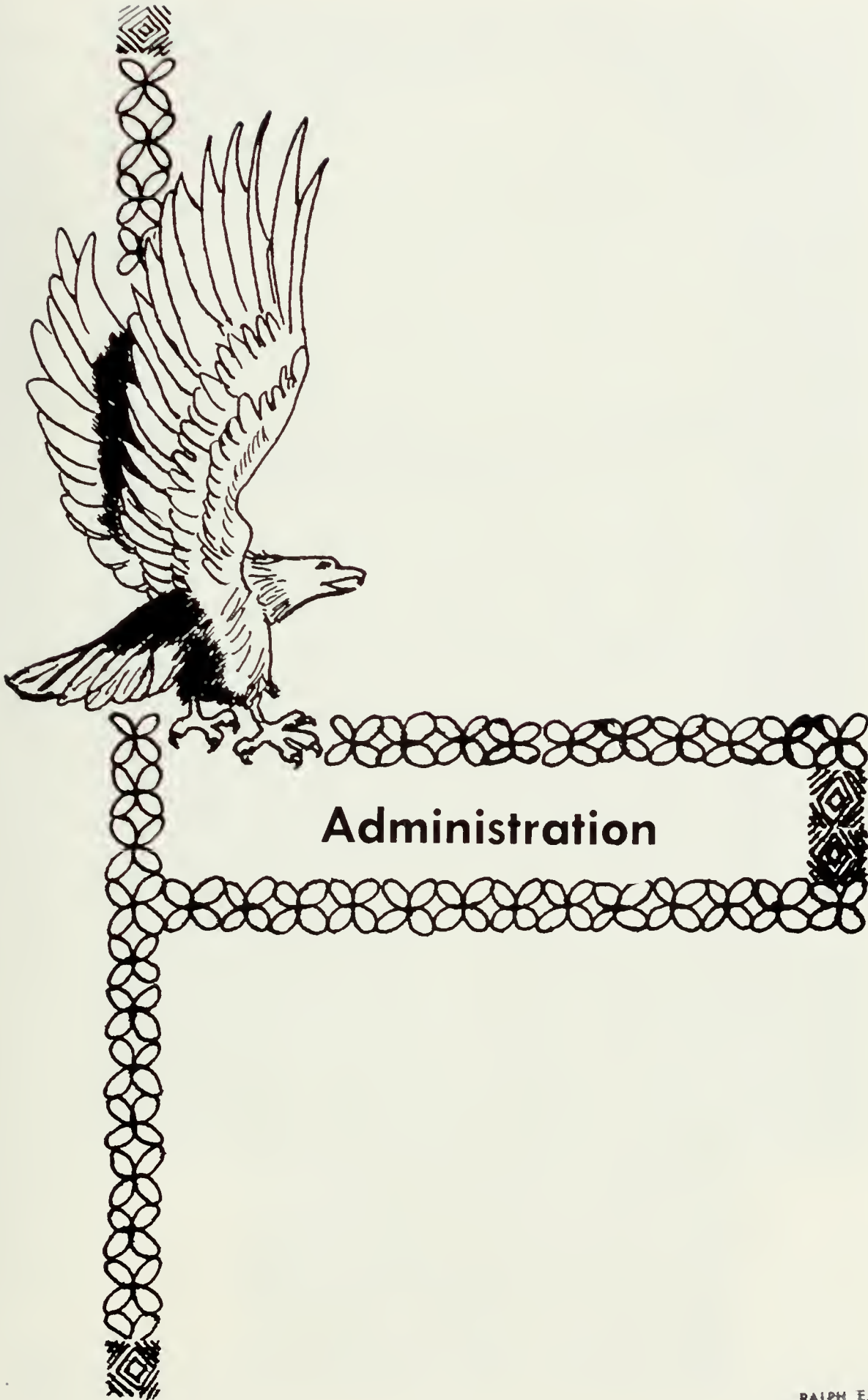
He has worked with the Class of '71 for two years. He has helped and encouraged us to higher achievements, laughed with us, and pushed us on.

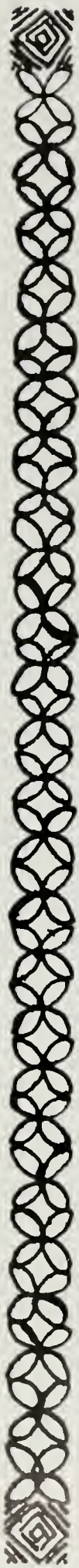
Brothers Douglas, Welton, Oakes, Purcell and Maxwell
