



MATTAPOISETT SELECTMEN'S MEETING FEBRUARY 19, 1991-by VIRGINIA MORGAN

State Senator Erving H. Wall, Jr. (R-Taunton) paid his first visit to the Board of Selectmen last Tuesday since being elected last November. He was accompanied by his associate, Roger Hoffmann.

"Basically", the senator said, "the concerns of all the towns in my district are the same - local aid." He said he hasn't changed from his stand when running for the office: supporting Question 3 state tax rollback, so-called CLT and Question 5, guaranteed local aid of 40 percent. "Mattapoisett is not in for the total cut", he noted. "Rural towns get belted because of the old formula; the new formula should help the smaller towns. There may have to be


some modification in the funds allocated for regional school districts which were not included in question 5 on the November ballot. As it now stands with the new formula, the school districts will have to receive their funds through the towns."

The senator said in Massachusetts the average part of the school budget for special education is 17.2 percent; nationwide the average is 11 percent. "Does this say Massachusetts does more or that the nation does less for special education?" There may be room for some relaxation of mandates unde Chapter 766 (the special education state law).

Selectman Bernard F. Talty expressed his opinion there may be room for cuts in the management layers of the human services budget. He noted he has seen personally the good work the hands-on workers do in the human services department of the state.

Senator Wall said he has been busy learning "the ropes" and getting to know the towns in his district. He said the Dukakis administration said there was a \$100 million deficit; Governor Weld says there is a \$850 million deficit and will have to make cuts accordingly. "We are hoping the deficit is more like \$700 million and if it is anything

less, we hope it will come back to the towns."

Selectmen Chairman John DeCosta explained Mattapoisett's local aid has been cut 23 percent in the past three years and cutting more each year. "We appreciate anything you can do and all the support you can give us." Mr. DeCosta added that the town's health costs have gone up 25 percent in the same period of time.

The senator explained he has been placed on the Natural Resources Committee and has worked on environmental and legislative issues, but "it would be presumptuous of me to make any statements until I have more experience."

Senator Wall said he is a native of Plymouth and was formerly a sales engineer with W.R. Grace. He served in the U.S. Navy for four years and 16 in the Naval Reserve.

In commenting on another state program which he termed "puzzling", Senator Wall noted the matching funds program should not be a criteria unless the program has some use. The state gets involved in matching funds and some should be looked into

In other business, Selectmen:

AWARDED A CONTRACT to Athol Press, Inc. of Athol to furnish 2,600 copies of the warrant for the May 4th annual town meeting and 2,000 copies of the 1990 annual town report. Their low bid out of six bidders also included a cost of \$3. each for half-tone pictures for the report.

With \$3,690 for the reports and \$1,068 for the warrants for a total of \$4,758 there will be additional costs for pictures and about \$500. for postage to mail the warrants. Voters approved \$9,000 for the printing.

Executive Secretary Carol Adams noted these six bidders are the most they have had for a job in a long time. She noted she had consulted with the executive secretary of Chelmsford who has used the Athol Press on several occasions and has been pleased with the job they did.



to the three towns. Mattapoisett's share will be \$1,988,637.62, up from \$1,795,194 from fiscal 1991. Selectmen noted this increase of about \$200,000 is up 10 percent and is based on the number of students Mattapoisett had as of September 1, 1990 in the system.

RECEIVED A LETTER from Gregory A.
Russo of Hudson in regards to the parking permits at the town wharf. "During the past 10 years", Mr. Russo wrote, "I have gone from non-resident to property owner to non-resident and I presently keep a mooring in the harbor and rely on access from the wharf. This year, since I presently do not own property in town, I will be without a parking permit."

Selectmen stressed the regulation states a person has to be a town resident to have a parking permit; however, there are several areas for parking for non-residents.





Indian Cove Trust is seeking permission from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to dredge 667 cubic yards of material from 9,000 square feet of an existing channel in Aucoot Cove, Mattapoisett, MA. Bela Bartok Conservatory, is a well-known figure on the Boston jazz scene. His music combines classical compositional and harmonic elements, improvisational jazz, and folk melodies and rhythms of Africa, the Middle East, Europe and India.

Gardony's most recent album, "The Legend of Tsumi" (Antilles, 1989), is a reflection of his interest in classical and folk forms. Its unusual meters and odd harmonies result in melodies which juxtapose rocking rhythms with contemplative phrases.

"We tried to go with the natural logic

of the melody", Gardony says.

Opening the festival at 7 p.m. March 4th will be a free intercollegiate jazz concert in the Campus Center Auditorium, featuring jazz bands from SMU, Westfield State College, Bridgewater State College, the University of Rhode Island, Rhode Island College, Providence College, Community College of Rhode Island, and Cape Cod Community College.

The Bobby Greene Ensemble, a traditional jazz group led by saxophonist and SMU faculty member Bobby Greene, performs in a free concert "Afro-American Music, Part II" at 12:30 p.m. March 5th in the Recital Hall (room 153) of the Visual and Performing arts (CVPA) building.



There may be other tests, depending upon the results of the basic examination.




