

Dear Monica:

We have received and reviewed January 11, 2016, correspondence and documentation 15-0106d: "Dakota Access Pipeline Project: Interim Clearance for Six (6) Terminal Sites." We concur with 'No Significant Sites Affected' determinations for: (1) Stanley Terminal, (2) Watford City Terminal, (3) Ramberg Greenfield Terminal, (4) Epping Terminal, (5) Trenton Lunnen Terminal provided each takes place in the location plotted in the project documentation, and for (6) Johnson Corner Terminal provided that unevaluated site 32MZZ864 is avoided from impacts until a formal evaluation and a review of derived significance findings have been completed. Interim access to the western half of the Johnson Corner Terminal parcel may be accomplished through an approved project routing involving matting as was discussed in the January 13 and January 14 consultation meetings.



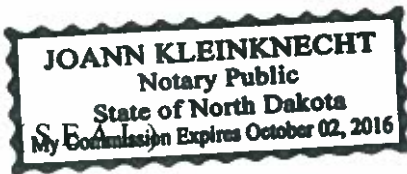
