The purpose of this letter is to confirm that the Dakota Access Pipeline (DAPL) is being designed with proper corrosion prevention systems. The first barrier of defense from corrosion is through the use of high-performance coatings (fusion bonded epoxy - FBE), followed by impressed current cathodic protection (ICCP) systems installed approximately every ten miles, at locations where electrical power is available, and wherever possible, in areas with relatively easy access.

The section of pipeline contained within the state of North Dakota, totaling approximately 358 miles, will have the following specifications:

- 12.75" O.D., 0.500" W.T., X-52, 14-16 MILS FBE w/40 MILS ARO
- 20.00" O.D., 0.438" W.T., X-70, 14-16 MILS FBE w/40 MILS ARO
- 24.00" O.D., $0.500^{\prime \prime}$ W.T., X-70, 14-16 MILS FBE w/40 MILS ARO
- 30.00 " O.D., $0.625^{\prime \prime}$ W.T., X-70, 14-16 MILS FBE w/40 MILS ARO

Note that abrasion resistant overcoat (ARO) will only be used through sections where pipe is more susceptible to sustaining coating damage during installation (e.g. horizontal directional drills, through bores). In the case of open-cut installations, 14-16 mils of FBE will be used.

As the firm designing the pipeline, have reviewed all applicable codes and specifications and are in full compliance with DOT 195, and NACE International. We are confident that the design is adequate for the pipeline.

## DAKOTA ACCESS PIPELINE PROJECT

The attached Utility Crossing Permit Applications are being submitted on behalf of Dakota Access, LLC.

Dakota Access is proposing to construct a new crude oil pipeline that will provide transportation service from points of origin in the Bakken/Three Forks play in North Dakota through portions of South Dakota and lowa to a terminus in Patoka, lllinois.

The proposed DAPL Project is comprised of an underground pipeline and associated tank terminals/pump stations for the storage and transport of crude petroleum. In North Dakota, the DAPL Project consists of two main underground pipeline components (Supply Line and Mainline), six tank/pump stations, and minor aboveground appurtenances (eg. Main line valves). The 151 mile long Supply Line Route will commence with a new 12" diameter pipeline east of Stanley, extend to the west and then south around Lake Sakakawea, ultimately reaching its terminus at Johnson Corner. The diameter of the pipeline increases incrementally at designated tank terminals from 12 inches to 20,24 and ultimately, 30 inches. The DAPL Project will provide shippers access to approximately 450,000 bpd of transportation capacity (with the ultimate capacity of 570,000 bpd or greater depending on customer demand).

Six tank terminals are proposed throughout the length of the Supply Line, including just west of the pipeline's commencement point near Stanley, and subsequent tank terminals locate south of Tioga, near Epping, near Trenton, Near Watford City and at Johnson Corner.

At the discharge side of the Johnson Corner tank terminal and pump station, the 30 inch diameter Mainline commences and heads in a general southeast direction through for approximately 210 miles before crossing the state line at the Emmons County, ND/Campbell County, SD border. Additionally, the Mainline crosses portions of South Dakota, lowa, and Illinois for a combined total of approximately 1,150 miles.

## Permits and Licenses with Private Individuals, Companies, Corporations, Etc. (referred to as Recipient):

Recipient agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the state of North Dakota, its agencies, officers and employees (State), from and against claims based on the vicarious liability of the State or its agents, but not against claims based on the State's contributory negligence, comparative and/or contributory negligence or fault, sole negligence, or intentional misconduct. The legal defense provided by the Recipient to the State under this provision must be free of any conflicts of interest, even if retention of separate legal counsel for the State is necessary. Recipient also agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold the State harmless for all costs, expenses and attorneys' fees incurred if the State prevails in an action against the Recipient in establishing and litigating the indemnification coverage provided herein. This obligation shall continue after the termination of this agreement.

Recipient shall secure and keep in force during the term of this agreement, from insurance companies, government self-insurance pools or government self-retention funds authorized to do business in North Dakota, the following insurance coverages:

1) Commercial general liability and automobile liability insurance - minimum limits of liability required are $\$ 250,000$ per person and $\$ 1,000,000$ per occurrence.

Any attorney who represents the State under this policy must first qualify as and be appointed by the North Dakota Attorney General as a Special Assistant Attorney General as required under N.D.C.C. Section 54-12-08.

The purpose of this letter is to confirm that the Dakota Access Pipeline (DAPL) is being designed with proper corrosion prevention systems. The first barrier of defense from corrosion is through the use of high-performance coatings (fusion bonded epoxy - FBE), followed by impressed current cathodic protection (ICCP) systems installed approximately every ten miles, at locations where electrical power is available, and wherever possible, in areas with relatively easy access.

The section of pipeline contained within the state of North Dakota, totaling approximately 358 miles, will have the following specifications:

- 12.75" O.D., 0.500" W.T., X-52, 14-16 MILS FBE w/40 MILS ARO
- 20.00" O.D., 0.438" W.T., X-70, 14-16 MILS FBE w/40 MILS ARO
- $24.00^{\prime \prime}$ O.D., $0.500^{\prime \prime}$ W.T., X-70, 14-16 MILS FBE w/40 MILS ARO
- $30.00^{\prime \prime}$ O.D., $0.625^{\prime \prime}$ W.T., X-70, 14-16 MILS FBE w/40 MILS ARO

## DAKOTA ACCESS PIPELINE PROJECT

The attached Utility Crossing Permit Applications are being submitted on behalf of Dakota Access, LLC.

Dakota Access is proposing to construct a new crude oil pipeline that will provide transportation service from points of origin in the Bakken/Three Forks play in North Dakota through portions of South Dakota and lowa to a terminus in Patoka, Illinois.

The proposed DAPL Project is comprised of an underground pipeline and associated tank terminals/pump stations for the storage and transport of crude petroleum. In North Dakota, the DAPL Project consists of two main underground pipeline components (Supply Line and Mainline), six tank/pump stations, and minor aboveground appurtenances (eg. Main line valves). The 151 mile long Supply Line Route will commence with a new 12" diameter pipeline east of Stanley, extend to the west and then south around Lake Sakakawea, ultimately reaching its terminus at Johnson Corner. The diameter of the pipeline increases incrementally at designated tank terminals from 12 inches to 20,24 and ultimately, 30 inches. The DAPL Project will provide shippers access to approximately 450,000 bpd of transportation capacity (with the ultimate capacity of $570,000 \mathrm{bpd}$ or greater depending on customer demand).

Six tank terminals are proposed throughout the length of the Supply Line, including just west of the pipeline's commencement point near Stanley, and subsequent tank terminals locate south of Tioga, near Epping, near Trenton, Near Watford City and at Johnson Corner.

At the discharge side of the Johnson Corner tank terminal and pump station, the 30 inch diameter Mainline commences and heads in a general southeast direction through for approximately 210 miles before crossing the state line at the Emmons County, ND/Campbell County, SD border. Additionally, the Mainline crosses portions of South Dakota, lowa, and Illinois for a combined total of approximately 1,150 miles.

6. No driveway, or improvement constructed on the hlghway right of way shall be eltarid or relocated without permission of the district engineer of NDDOT.
7. The Applicant agrees to perform all work in accordance with this permit, and to indemnify and hold harmiess NDDOT, its officers, and employees from any and all liability, judgments, costs, expenses, and claims growing out of damages, or alleged damages, of any nature whatscever, to any person or property arising out of performance or nonperformance of said work, or the existence of said driveways.
8.
