The State Engineers Office received an application for a temporary water permit from Dakota Access, LLC on May 26, 2016. This application requested the authorization to use 4.6 acre-feet of water at a maximum rate of withdrawal of 2,400 gallons per minute an un-named slough. The requested point of diversion (POD) listed on the application is at 15609225BC in Mountrail County. The requested period of withdrawal was 7/1/16 through 2/28/17. The nature of use for the proposed allocation was listed as "Hydrostatic Testing", which is cataloged as "Construction-Hydrostatic Testing".

A hydrologic review was completed as part of the review process for the temporary water permit application.

The hydrologic review of the proposed pumping from the POD on un-named slough in the Town of Stanley sub-watershed, Little Knife River watershed, and Lake Sakakawea sub-basin, will not adversely affect existing rights.

Therefore, the temporary water permit application submitted by Dakota Access, LLC to withdraw 4.6 acre-feet of water at a maximum rate of 2400 gpm from the above listed source for a timeframe beginning 7/25/16 and ending 2/28/17 is recommended for approval with the conditions attached to this permit.
