The State Engineers Office received an application for a temporary water permit from Dakota Access, LLC on 6/16/16. This application requested the authorization to use 61.4 acre-feet of water at a maximum rate of withdrawal of 2000 gallons per minute from "Beaver Creek". The requested point of diversion (POD) listed on the application is at 13207709BC of Emmons County. The requested period of withdrawal was 7/1/16 through 4/14/17. The nature of use for the proposed allocation was listed as "Hydrostatic testing", which is cataloged as "Construction".

A hydrologic review was completed as a part of the review process for the temporary water permit application.

The hydrologic review of the proposed pumping from the POD on Beaver Creek, in the Maier Lake-Beaver Creek sub-watershed, Beaver Creek-Lake Oahe watershed, and Beaver sub-basin will not adversely affect existing rights.

Therefore, the temporary water permit application submitted by Dakota Access, LLC to withdraw 61.4 acre-feet of water at a maximum rate of 2000 gpm from the above listed source for a timeframe beginning 7/27/16 and ending 12/31/16 is recommended for approval with the conditions attached to this permit.
