Commissioners:

I have received notification from Kathy Moreno, a HR representative of Dakota Access, indicating that an employee of Precision Pipeline LLC (DAPL subcontractor) was injured on Saturday (8/27/16) on Spread 7, near Mandan.

According to Moreno, in a failed attempt to enter a personnel transport bus through an emergency exit door, the employee slipped and hit his head on a rock. He was transported to a medical care facility, treated for a concussion, released, and is now back to work.

Per the Certification to Order Provisions attached to the Order in this case (provision #27, see below), Dakota Access is required to notify the Commission within five business days when an injury to any person occurs.

- 27. Company understands and agrees that it shall advise the Commission of any extraordinary events which take place at the site of the transmission facility, including injuries to any person, or the death of any threatened or endangered species on the site within five business days of such event.**
