Commissioners:

This afternoon I received an update from Kathy Moreno concerning DAPL reportable injury #8.

Moreno indicated that the individual involved was an apprentice electrician who was working alone in wet conditions, both of which factors contributed to the accident. She has been discharged from St. Alexius (hospitalized for two days) with a back brace as treatment for her injury. It is unknown when or if she will return to work.

Moreno further indicated that the company has notified OSHA of the incident.

Commissioners:

I have received notification this morning from Kathy Moreno (HR representative for Dakota Access), who stated that an employee of CEI (DAPL electrical subcontractor) was injured yesterday (10/17/16) on Spread 9 at the Epping Station tie-in.

According to Moreno, the female employee was injured when a ladder she was standing on slipped, she fell, and the ladder fell on top of her. The individual is currently hospitalized in Bismarck with a fractured vertebra or vertebrae.

Moreno will be calling with additional details later today once more information on the nature of the injuries and circumstances surrounding the incident are known.

Per the Certification to Order Provisions attached to the Order in this case (provision #27, see below), Dakota Access is required to notify the Commission within five business days when an injury to any person occurs.

- 27. Company understands and agrees that it shall advise the Commission of any extraordinary events which take place at the site of the transmission facility, including injuries to any person, or the death of any threatened or endangered species on the site within five business days of such event.**
