

6/1/96 These H.L.H. and pages were discussed by the Assassination Secret, Select Board. They have nothing at all to do with the JFK assassination. Some of the information was decided that one of the Dealey Plaza Tramps was King. Some called another Frank Sturgis. James' writing was chiefly chaff, as some criticism reflect. This selection of records does not reflect more than on those chief records such as Bell's ^{items} was

If I understand some of the records correctly the CIA was actually paying James to write that chaff with his fingerprints about the heads of the CIA.

That Bill Buckley seems to have been no more than a wealthy gadfly is interesting but not really important. It was a fine "cover" that was important of his to do instead of using that as a cover for what else he did he only got around. Thus his short CIA career

Most of the disclosed records that have brought to light have no assassin's connection. They relate to the various phases of the rather large amount of Mexico City work. This is legit in etc because Oswald was there + the CIA went crazy over that. Again may that be the case.

But records that directly address alleged assassination evidence seem to be few & to have attracted little or no public attention.
