Klan Burns Cross

FINKSBURG, Md., Aug. 12 (AP)—A 25-foot-high wooden cross was burned in an open field near this Carroll County community last night during a Ku Klux Klan meeting.

About 200 persons gathered for the rally, which was observed at a distance by local and State police.

Roy E. Frankhouser, who identified himself as the Imperial Representative of Pennsylvania, called on those attending to support George Wallace for President and "there will be a white revolt that will cleanse out Nation for once and for all."
