

Klan Members Face Drug Indictments

BALTIMORE (AP)—Five men listed by police as members of the Ku Klux Klan have been indicted on charges of kidnaping a 21-year-old man suspected of selling narcotics to Klan members.

Conspiracy and assault charges also were brought against the five men. Three others arrested at the same time were being held for investigation.

Police said the youth, whose

name they withheld, told them he was stopped on the street in the Pimlico area and forced to accompany a group of men to a wooded area, where they threatened his life.

He said he also was roughed up before being returned to the area where he had been picked up 1½ hours earlier.

Named in the indictments were Anthony Laricci, 40, Robert L. Carroll Jr., 35, David R. Peariso, 24, Charles H. McMahon, 25, and Charles L. Love Jr., 19.
