**Contempt Charges Dropped** 

Contempt Charges Dropped Against 3 Officials of Klan Mither 2013/14 WASHINGTON, May 2 (AP) — Contempt - of - Congress charges were dismissed today against three Ku Klux Klan officials accused with four oth-ers of refusing to turn over Klan records for a House in-vestigation. David G. Bress, United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, said an investigation by his office supported the three Klan officials's conten-tion that they did not have the records that were subpoenade by the House Committee on Un-American Activities for its 1966 inquiry. Freed by the action were Robert Hudgins, 35 years old, of Cary, N. C.; George F. Dor-sett, 51, of Greensboro, N. C.; and Marshall R. Kernegay, 40, of Raleigh, N. C. When indicted in 1966, Hudg-ins was the Klan's imperial secretary, Dorsett its chaplain and Kernegay the grand drag-on for Virginia.
