

Klan Plans to Investigate Charleston Book Dispute

STONE MOUNTAIN, GA.,
Dec. 30 (UPI)—The Ku Klux
Klan plans to investigate school
board members and textbook
company executives in a West
Virginia school book controver-
sy. It says Communists are out
to subvert American children
with "obscene" books.

James R. Venable, imperial
wizard of the National Knights
of the Ku Klux Klan, said yester-
day that a delegation would
go to Charleston to begin an in-
quiry into the motives of pub-
lishers and school board mem-
bers responsible for texts that
have triggered parental protest
against books being used in the
public schools there.

He said the Klan would retain
lawyers to look into the corpor-
ate structures of the textbook
publishers.
