

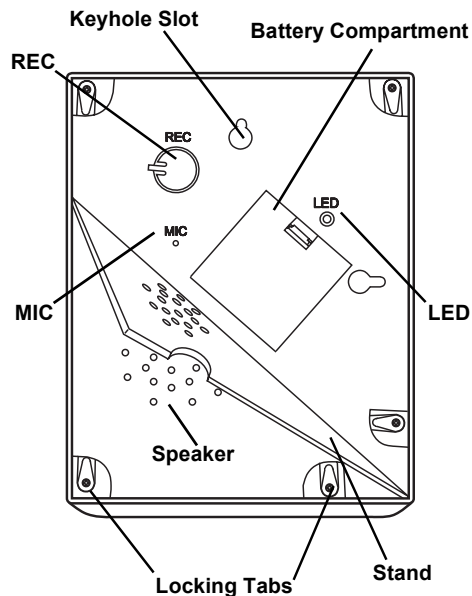

5"×7" Recording Picture Frame

Your RadioShack 5"×7" Recording Picture Frame lets you record and play back up to 10 seconds of sound to accompany a favorite picture. It uses the latest integrated circuit recording technology, so you can record a new message as many times as you like without having to wait for a tape to rewind.

Back View of Picture Frame

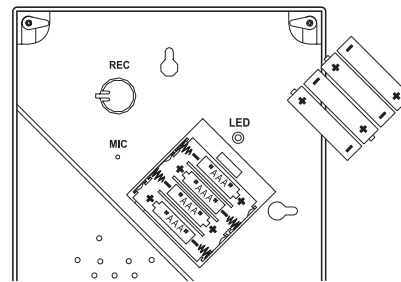


Cautions:

- Use only fresh batteries of the required size and recommended type.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, different types of batteries (standard, alkaline, or rechargeable), or rechargeable batteries of different capacities.

Follow these steps to install batteries.

1. Press the tab on the battery compartment cover, then lift off the cover.



2. Place the batteries in the compartment as indicated by the polarity symbols (+ and -) marked inside.
3. Replace the cover.

When the sound becomes weak or distorted, or the recording picture frame stops operating properly, replace the batteries.

The recording picture frame keeps the message in memory, even if it loses battery power.

Warning: Dispose of old batteries promptly and properly. Do not burn or bury them.

Caution: If you do not plan to use the recording picture frame for a month or longer,

INSTALLING BATTERIES

Your recording picture frame uses four AAA batteries (not supplied) for power. For the best performance and longest life, we recommend RadioShack alkaline batteries.

remove the batteries. Batteries can leak chemicals that can destroy electronic parts.

place the frame on a flat surface with the stand extended.

FRAMING THE PICTURE

Follow these steps to place any of three different photo sizes (3"x5", 4"x6", or 5"x7") into the recording picture frame.

1. With the picture frame face-down, unlatch the three locking tabs on the back of the picture frame, then flip up the lower cover (stand) to disengage the other two locking tabs.
2. Grasp the stand and lift it up to detach the back cover.
3. *To place a 3"x5", or 4"x6" picture into the picture frame*, place the supplied black photo frame on the clear PVC plate, then place the picture face-down on the black frame.

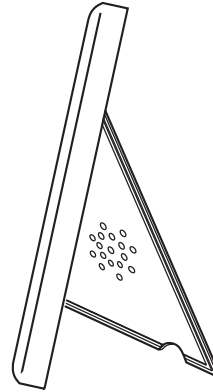
To place a 5"x7" picture into the picture frame, place the picture face-down on the clear PVC plate.

4. Replace the back cover and secure it with the five locking tabs.

Mounting the Picture Frame

You can place the picture frame vertically or horizontally on a desk, shelf, or table using the built-in stand. Or, you can mount it on a wall using one screw (not supplied) and the keyhole slot on the back of the frame.

Extend the stand as far away as it will go from the back of the picture frame. Then



RECORDING A MESSAGE

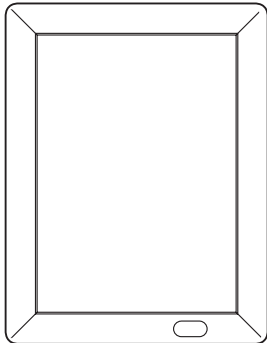
Follow these steps to record a message up to 10 seconds long.

1. Hold down **REC** on the back of the picture frame. **LED** lights and the picture frame records for as long as you hold the button down (up to 10 seconds).
2. Hold the picture frame about 6 inches away and speak toward **MIC** (microphone) on the back of the frame.
3. To stop recording, release **REC**.

To record a new message, repeat Steps 1–3. The new message replaces the old one.

PLAYING THE MESSAGE

To listen to the recorded message, press the button at the lower right on the front picture frame.

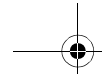

CARE

To enjoy your Recording Picture Frame for a long time:

- Keep the picture frame dry. If it gets wet, wipe it dry immediately.
- Use and store the picture frame only in normal temperature environments.
- Handle the picture frame gently and carefully. Don't drop it.
- Keep the picture frame away from dust and dirt.
- Wipe the picture frame with a damp cloth occasionally to keep it looking new.

Modifying or tampering with the picture frame's internal components can cause a malfunction and invalidate its warranty. If your picture frame is not performing as it should, take it to your local RadioShack store for assistance.

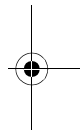
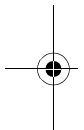
