The Southern Observatory for Human Rights (SOHR) issues its Annual Report for 2012 amid an escalation of the abuses committed by the Yemeni Regime's forces against the political rights and fundamental freedoms of the People of the South; a trend which confirms that the Yemeni regime – in the post-change era - continues to employ the same approach that its predecessor adopted towards the South and the aspirations of its People. The present Report is a continuation of the reports issued in the past few years, which included documentation of the abuses committed by the Yemeni Regime's forces against the People of the South, thereby receiving interest and attention from Arab and international human rights organizations. This was reflected in the stance of the international public opinion, which denounced those heinous violations and those responsible for them<sup>1</sup>.

### **Introduction**

The suffering of the People of the South of Yemen as a result of the grave violations committed by the Yemeni Authorities' forces, and the sacrifices of the People of the South; hundreds of martyrs and thousands of wounded for the cause of their homeland, the South; brought its national cause to the attention of the international community, which has given this matter its consideration, criticizing the Yemeni Government's record in this regard, and calling for investigations in the actions it committed. In this connection, the Southern Observatory values the field missions carried out by a delegation of the United Nations High Commission for Human Rights to the province of Aden, as well as a delegation representing Amnesty International, and a team from Médecins Sans Frontières, and other international humanitarian organizations. This sent a signal confirming that the question of the rights of the Southern citizen is under international scrutiny, leading the UN Security Council reiterating, in its resolution No. 2051 of 2012, to stress that all those responsible for human rights violations and abuses must be held accountable, and underlining the need for a 'comprehensive, independent and impartial investigation consistent with international standards into alleged human

rights abuses and violations, to prevent impunity and ensure full accountability<sup>2</sup>. In addition, those violations are continuously followed by the United Nations Human Rights Council, as well as its Complaint Procedure, which will report to the Council during its upcoming session due to take place in April<sup>3</sup>.

The Southern Observatory for Human Rights had contacted the United Nations Human Rights Council, and called upon the Council to undertake advocacy for establishing a mechanism for the protection of human rights in Southern Yemen, as well as the urgent intervention in order to put an end to violations, prosecute their perpetrators, and compensate the victims. The Observatory has also urged the Council to appoint a special rapporteur on human rights in the South of Yemen<sup>4</sup>, so that the People of the South do not constantly remain victims of internationally criminalized violations. In this regard, The Observatory has also demanded that the United Nations High Commission open a field office in the city of Aden in parallel to its existing office in Sana'a, provided that its duties not be limited to logistic support, but that its tasks would include monitoring and documentation of abuses committed by the Yemeni Regime's forces against the People of the South.

Pending the formation of an international committee, the Southern Observatory calls for the formation of an 'Impartial National Southern Committee' to consider and investigate such violations, which affected thousands of people in the South, along the lines of what has been approved by the Human Rights Council and confirmed by the UN Security Council on the situation in Yemen, in order to 'prevent impunity'.

Nevertheless, the Observatory holds both its opinion and proposal pertaining to the need for an international commission to investigate those violations, as a mechanism to ensure the victims' right to justice and to hold the perpetrators accountable for their crimes. The Observatory furthermore hopes that a special rapporteur on human rights in Yemen be

appointed, particularly considering the Yemeni Government's procrastination regarding the implementation of the Human Rights Council resolution on this matter.

The abuses against citizens in the South, which the Southern Observatory monitored and documented throughout the past year are alarming both in terms of their frequent occurrence and their grave nature. These include extrajudicial killings, attempted murder leading to injuries of varying degrees, arbitrary arrests, abductions, targeting citizens' homes, bombarding and imposing blockades on towns and villages, in addition to other gross violations of human rights to security and appropriate living conditions<sup>5</sup>.

The overall nature of these violations demonstrates that they are committed in accordance with a consistent official policy against the People of the South as a result of them demanding to achieve their aspirations for freedom and the restoration of their independent state. This statement is supported by the fact that those violations are committed in similar patterns and that the perpetrators are not subjected to any form of accountability about their grave actions, enjoying full impunity before the victims' families without a fair punishment. This clearly confirms that such violations are committed with the consent of the political and military leaders in the Yemeni regime<sup>6</sup>.

### **The Methodology of Monitoring and Documentation**

The Southern Observatory issues its Annual Report for 2012, its third Annual Report; with the information it contains being based on the Observatory daily work in monitoring human rights related proceedings, and the reports received from its field correspondents and activists operating in the South, in addition to the complaints it received from victims reporting on abuses targeting them, as well as broadcasts by news agencies, newspapers and websites. Furthermore, the Observatory's monthly and quarterly reports for that year and the press releases it issued constitute a reference for the present Annual Report, which is the result of the monitoring and documentation work over the period from January to December 2012.

Central to the Southern Observatory's Report is reporting on violations to political and civil rights; these are considered priority aspects as they are related to direct threats faced by the People of the South, such as killings, injuries arrests, torture and armed attacks on towns and villages; whereas other causes of concern pertaining to economic and social rights, including women's and children's rights, discrimination in civil service and other challenges, are to be addressed in independent reports. The Observatory also chose not to mention numerous cases of abuse that occurred during the reporting period to keep the Report concise. The reader may wish, however, to refer to previous quarterly reports for details on such cases.

### **The Political Background of Human Rights Violations in South Yemen**

Citizens in Southern Yemen feel deprived of their rights, in particular their right to self-determination and an independent state which they already enjoyed until 1990, when the Yemeni Regime denied them those rights following the failed unification of the two states. Citizens in the South of Yemen are determined to restore those legitimate rights based on the peoples' right to liberation and self-determination<sup>7</sup>. The Yemeni Regime confronts the entitlements of the South with repression, and seeks to suppress any calls to achieve these aspirations.

Against the backdrop of such a political background, the People of South Yemen have been and continue to be subjected to various forms of gross violations of their rights, including the right to life, free expression, security and stability. The denial of those rights resulted in the citizens' life in South Yemen becoming vulnerable, and increasingly so as the Yemeni authorities created hotbeds of imbalances in various spheres, in addition to the grave state of lawlessness, characterized by bombings, assassinations and random shootings. This state of affairs encouraged outlaw groups, if not operating at the behest of the authorities; to further destabilize the security situation in the South of Yemen<sup>8</sup>.

Citizens in South Yemen had hoped for a breakthrough in the political conditions following the political changes that took place in the structure of the Yemeni Regime. However, things kept going in the same direction as they did before, and there was no change in policies regarding the South of Yemen. It became then evident that the change in the Yemeni Regime did not have any impact on the policy towards the South, and that the current Regime's policies towards the South are merely a continuation of the *fait accompli* approach employed by the former Regime.

Citizens of the South of Yemen expressed their disapproval of the continuation of such policies, and rejected any improvements in the structure of the Yemeni Regime, including the presidential elections held in February 2011, which the Southerners boycotted. In addition, they had a firm stance on refraining from participating in the 'National Dialogue Conference' scheduled to take place in March 2013, arguing that it is irrelevant for the People of the South, and stressing their aspirations to freedom and independence from the Yemeni Regime, and their ambitions to restore their independent national state.

In parallel with this position, the citizens of South Yemen had endeavoured during the past year to make their voices heard by the public opinion on the regional and international levels, through organizing peaceful events such as commemorating the Southern Prisoner's Day on every Thursday of each week, as well as the Southern Student's Day on every Monday of each week, in addition to other national events that were marked during that year, most notably a million man march that was organized on October 14<sup>th</sup> to commemorate the 49<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the South's revolution against British colonialism, and another million man march to commemorate the 45<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the South's independence from Britain on November 30<sup>th</sup>. Those two events have been considered a referendum where the People of the South expressed its will to restore its independent state<sup>9</sup>.

## **The Reality of Human Rights Violations in South Yemen**

The Southern citizens' determination to achieve their goals of liberation and an independent state has triggered a reaction in the opposite direction, as the Yemeni Regime was determined to suppress those aspirations using every means within its capacity, including the military. The Regime does not hesitate in using live ammunition against the participants in peaceful demonstrations, as it did during a youth march that was organized by the Southern Revolutionary Forces Coordination Council in the city of Ataq on October 17<sup>th</sup>, resulting in six persons being wounded. Another incident is live shooting at young female activists from the province of Aden on September 26<sup>th</sup>, after they took part in a march that took place in the city of Al-Dhali'. In addition, protesting university students have been shot at on December 17<sup>th</sup> by one of the soldiers affiliated with the authorities.

The Regime often cracks down on activists in the National Movement of the South and silencing its political opponents among scholars and media figures, subjecting them to arbitrary arrest, in addition to the use of trials before state security courts against those who call for disengagement from the Yemen Arab Republic<sup>10</sup>. For instance, the Criminal Court specializing in state security cases has summoned on Sunday, November 25<sup>th</sup> 2012 Brigadier General Abdou Alma'tari, President of the Retirees Society, along with other fellow members of the Society, on charges of 'undermining the unity of Yemen'. Furthermore, the authorities use various approaches, including persuasion, intimidation and malicious prosecution to limit freedom of press and the media<sup>11</sup>.

## **The Number of Cases of Gross Violations during 2012**

As it fulfilled its mandate in monitoring and documenting the violations committed against the citizens of the South, the Southern Observatory for Human Rights (SOHR) has documented in 2012 268 violations of the right to life due to extrajudicial killings. It also documented 701 cases of attempted murder leading to injuries, in addition to 364 cases of arbitrary arrest and abduction against activists in the Southern Movement, most

of who were subjected to torture and ill treatment. 95 cases of targeting homes and civilian facilities with destruction and varying degrees of damage were also documented. All these grave violations were committed against Southern citizens putting their lives at risk, which indicates that they are part of a systematic policy adopted by the Yemeni regime, contrary to the Regime's allegations that these are separate and individual accidents. This policy confirms the lack of the Yemeni Government's respect for human rights in South Yemen, and unequivocally proves that it has indeed renounced its international obligations towards the South.

The Southern Observatory for Human Rights (SOHR) avails itself of this opportunity to call again upon the United Nations Commission and the international monitoring mechanisms to intensify their attention to the violations taking place in South Yemen, and to take actions that would put an end to such gross violations, and ensure the respect of human rights and fundamental freedoms. It also calls upon Arab and international humanitarian organizations to undertake the cause of Southern Civil Rights, bring this question to the attention of the Arab and international public opinion, and to coordinate the process of referring those violations to the International Criminal Court in order to ensure the prevention of impunity.

### **Forms of Human Rights Violations in South Yemen**

#### **1. The Denial of the Right to Life through the Use of Extrajudicial Killing and Injuring:**

In accordance with their policies of suppressing opposition in the National Southern Movement, the Yemeni Regime Forces pointed their arms at the chests of the Southern Revolution's activists, labelling them as 'separatists', and using this as a pretext to target people participating in peaceful protests. Reckless and random shootings did not spare even those who were just carrying their everyday activities in public or at their own homes, not to mention the victims of bombarding on many towns and villages. All those violations were committed with complete disregard to the laws, humanitarian or religious values.



None of the victims could have posed a threat on the Regime's forces. The crimes are committed without warning, and without resorting to non-lethal methods of deterrence to disperse peaceful demonstrations. It is established that the Authorities forces used professional's snipers to kill many of the activists in the Southern Movement during their participation in peaceful demonstrations, as was the case with martyr Shadi Ya'qoub on Friday, June 15<sup>th</sup>, and martyr Saleh Matash on February 21<sup>st</sup>.

Security patrols chased a number of protesters in the streets and alleys of Al-Mu'alla Street on December 5<sup>th</sup> and fired bullets in the air to disperse the march which was organized to coincide with a visit by diplomats from the European Union to the Province of Aden. In the City of Ataq, the authorities' forces opened fire on a peaceful march on May 24<sup>th</sup>, resulting in a number of participants being injured, and in the City of Si'oun, those forces targeted a peaceful march on August 12<sup>th</sup>, as well as in the districts of AlMansoura and Al Mualla, Creter, Dar Saad and At-Tawahi of Aden Province, on July 21<sup>st</sup>, as they protested the constant disruption of electricity supply<sup>12</sup>. Ten young people from the directorate of Sah in Hadramout have been wounded on Monday, July 2<sup>nd</sup>, as a result of the authorities' forces shooting at them as they participated in sit in outside Total, an oil company operating in the directorate.

In many cases, the Yemeni Authorities' forces not only opened fire on protests and marches, but also subjected the funerals of those who died in military action to similar aggression with complete disrespect. This was the case during the funerals of both martyrs Sameh Yazidi and Mohammad Hamidi on March 30<sup>th</sup> in the 'Alqatee' cemetery in the city of Creter in Aden Province. And in an outrageous incident that took place on June 22<sup>nd</sup>, the forces opened fire on the mourners during the funeral of a young man, Ahmad Jamal Hydera, in the Directorate of Al-Mansoura, resulting in two people bring killed and six injured. The Authorities' forces did not spare ambulances either, and they prevent ambulances from saving the lives of those injured in shootings. For instance, on June 18<sup>th</sup>, the troops prevented an ambulance that had come to rescue individuals who were targeted by snipers in the city of Al-Mansoura. Preventing the provision of medical attention to the wounded is considered a war crime, as it results in the wounded dying

despite the possibility of saving their lives. One example of the brutality of those forces is the case of the political activist martyr Mahmoud Mohammed Azza'im; after gunning him down in the back, an armoured vehicle passed over his body, then he was killed, and his body was dragged and mutilated in front of a crowd of people. In other incidents, a number of activists were killed in their homes, such as the martyr Sharaf Mahfouz, and martyr Fairuz Al-Yafe'i who was killed during shooting that targeted her home, to name only a few.

The Yemeni Regime's forces make random shootings in residential neighbourhoods, and conduct provocative parades with their military vehicles; thereby outraging the residents whose family members were victims of random shooting and ammunition falling back from the air, as was the case with the child Ahmed Bahmbash in the Creter district of Aden. Martyr Fairuz Al-Yafe'i was killed in her bedroom in October following a fatal injury in her head. This murder caused deep resentment among the locals, and security officials have later justified it by saying that this operation took place by mistake. In this connection, one must point out that the Authorities' forces often attempt to justify their crimes through fabricating accounts that are contradictory to actual proceedings, generally denying any involvement or claiming that unknown parties are responsible for them. This was the case after the killing of citizen Abed Rabbo Jaradi on October 4<sup>th</sup>, when the armed forces alleged that the killing occurred after the insurgents attacked a security checkpoint.

Despite the grave nature of these crimes, the perpetrators remain free from investigation and are not held accountable for what they have committed. When reported, the judicial authorities neglects the abuses and do not open an investigation, and if they had to, the investigations would lack due process that is essential to bring those responsible for the crimes to justice. Therefore, the perpetrators remain unpunished with the complicity of the judicial authorities themselves. Faris Jamil Mohammed Khadr was killed on December 11<sup>th</sup>, and his father continued to follow his son's case with the judicial authorities in vain. Despite the fact that the murderer confessed his crime, the leadership of the brigade to which he belongs continues to dilute the case and even assist the perpetrator to go into hiding, and ignored the prosecution's orders to extradite him.

In most cases, the victims' families do not dare report the crimes for fear of reprisal, in addition to them knowing that such actions are ineffectual, as different authorities act in a systematic manner.

## **2. Cases of Attempted Murder Leading to Traumatic Injuries:**

The wounded and injured are often denied medical assistance by shooting at those who dare to extend a helping hand. Many died due to excessive bleeding after sustaining injuries. A number of individuals were arrested while they bled, as was the case with Abdullah Mabrouk on August 11<sup>th</sup> when he was denied his right to saving his life when injured. Some other injured detainees are only taken to hospital after their conditions have severely deteriorated, whereas abusive treatment continues at the health facility, and their rights both as detainees and injured persons are violated. In some cases they were beaten at the hospital, therefore most of the wounded seek treatment in places where the Regime cannot reach them. One of the most disturbing practices is arresting the injured, then subjecting them to torture inside detention centres before killing them. This happened to martyr Sadiq Ahmed Ali Salem on March 18<sup>th</sup><sup>13</sup>. In a separate incident, unidentified masked men had intercepted the vehicle of the political activist Abdul Rau'f Hassan Zaid, the general coordinator of the Tahrir Square in Al-Mu'alla directorate, then one of them opened fire on his car, and he sustained injuries in the abdomen. A group of from the security apparatus had already arrested him twice over the past few months, and raided his home.

## **3. Arbitrary Arrests:**

Arbitrary arrest is a restriction of one's physical freedom without legal justification or judicial proceedings. It is conducted without permission from Public Prosecution or a warrant, summons, or even disclosing the reason for the arrest or the charges on which it is based. Domestic and international laws do not provide for this kind of arrest, and considered it a violation of human rights.

Arbitrary arrest is exercised against the People of the South in the absence of legal oversight and accountability. The detainees are thrown into official and non-official prisons. It is yet another pattern punitive measure that the Yemeni Authorities' forces use to intimidate the activists taking part in peaceful protests. Southern intellectuals, scholars

and journalists have also become targets of arbitrary arrests and abductions, and their homes are raided at night and tampered with, while terrorizing the women and children. Among those arrested is the 'Dean of Southern Prisoners' Bgash Al-Aghbari and his comrade Yasser Al-ezeiby, who were transferred from Aden to Sana'a without legal justification. In addition, the arrest of both Sheikh Hassan Bannan Al-dyouli, the presidency member of the Supreme Council of the peaceful Movement for the Liberation of the South, and writer Ahmad Bal-faqih; was motivated by their political positions. When imprisoned, political detainees become more susceptible to denial of their rights as they do not have access to legal aid or a human rights lawyer. They are not referred to public prosecution or the judiciary; rather, they are often confined for lengthy periods, reaching several years in some cases. While in detention, they are rarely examined by a health care provider, and denied family visits. Those who attempt to visit them or follow their cases could face arrest in turn. Many of them are subsequently brought to trial under trumped-up charges, and receive harsh sentences including capital punishment, as was the case with the detainee Fares Al-dhalai.

For the Authorities' forces, arbitrary arrests, in addition to being a form of punishment; also send a powerful message to terrorize and intimidate other political activists, as some faced prolonged detention for many years, such as Ali Al-qasmi. No distinction is made between men and women or adults and minors. Many women and children were victims of such arrests, including the political activist Zahra Saleh and the two children; Motaz Al'esayi and Abdulaziz Mahyoub. Moreover, many citizens are arrested instead of their hounded relatives, for instance the case of citizen Abdullah Nasser Al-Shu'aibi who was arrested to put pressure on his son Ramzi, the Chairman of the Movement Council in Almsemir Directorate, whom the authorities sought to arrest as a result of his political activism.

Driven by hatred towards the Southern Movement's activists, the Regime forces deny the wounded access to medical attention, and instead, arrest and confine them without treatment. Under such circumstances, their suffering is doubled and their lives are at risk. The wounded who have been fortunate enough to reach the hospital could face other inhumane practices, as they may be arrested while receiving treatment in hospitals. This

has happened repeatedly and many were arrested from inside hospitals and intensive care units, such as Ja'bal Al-Burkani and Hani Jamil Saadan, who have been arrested from Annaqeeb hospital in Aden. The same happened to the wounded Nasser Ali Al-Qadhi, and there was an attempt to arrest the wounded Halim Qasim Al-Shu'aibi. Those actions prompted Médecins Sans Frontières working in the Southern city of Aden to halt its operations in protest against those arrests that are devoid of human, moral and religious values<sup>14</sup>. As a result of chasing the wounded at hospitals, many of them are forced to hide where the Regime forces cannot reach them, and where they might be able to receive some form of treatment without adequate medical supervision or attention.

Arbitrary arrests often involve various atrocities. On Sunday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, the Authorities' forces in the region of Gail Bawazir in Hadramout province arrested a group of locals who had organized a sit in protesting against those forces' provocative acts, and used live ammunition and excessive force to disperse the crowd. After subjecting citizens to torture and terror, the leader of the Southern Movement, writer Ahmed Salim Belfaqih was arrested, along with a number of political activists, including Omar Saeed Al-Bashiri, Saeed Al-Tamimi, Saeed Al-Fadhli and others. They were taken away as they were bleeding, and while in detention, the forces subjected them to different forms of torture that caused visible injuries and wounds. Ahmed Belfkih suffered severe injuries in the back as well as the pelvis and armpits, while Saeed al-Tamimi was brutally beaten with batons, causing additional fractures to his already broken arm.

According to the website of 'Aden News Agency', the prison belonging to that military force, which is led by a colonel named 'Al-Darrab'; consists of two metal containers, which exacerbates suffering and torture due to extreme heat during day time and extreme cold during the night.

Among the methods of torture that have been described is 'symbolic execution', to which the leader Ahmed Belfkih swas subjected. The aforementioned colonel 'Al-Darrab' orders the guards to execute a given detainee, and then they would point their weapons at

his head causing him a nervous breakdown. On the other hand, colonel 'Al-Darrab systematically denies that a detainee is held in this prison leading his family to believe that he may have been executed, as a means of magnifying the terror inflicted on them<sup>15</sup>.

In the face of the Authorities' forces' intransigence and depriving the detainees of most of their rights as politicians prisoners, many of whom choose to go on hunger strikes as the only way to attain their rights. The leader in the Movement, Sheikh Hassan Bannan, and his two comrades, Abed Rabbo Muharraq and Khaled Saleh, went on a hunger strike on March 2<sup>nd</sup> in protest against their treatment while in detention, including subjecting them to torture. It is worth noting that the three detainees have been languishing in the Yemeni Authorities' prisons in the city of Sana'a for over five months now.

Family members of those held in Al-Mansoura prison reported to the website of 'Aden Alghad' on September 12<sup>th</sup>, that the detainees are subjected to torture, brutal beatings and ill-treatment by the soldiers. In addition to forcing them to drink sewage water. The website of 'Aden Life' published photos of a number of prisoners, showing signs of torture on their bodies resulting from beating with electric cables and cigarettes. The same source added that the abused prisoners were forced to drink from a sewer after being tortured.

#### **4. Forced Disappearances:**

Every now and then, the Authorities' forces abduct activists in the Southern Movement, in a terrorist gang like manner. Abductions are conducted using civilian vehicles without number plates, and are carried out by masked soldiers in civilian clothes armed with pistols. The activists are taken to unknown locations, and there they are interrogated and subjected to beatings and degrading treatment, in addition to threats and intimidation. One instance of such acts is the abduction of the activist in the Southern Movement Nawfal Abdul-Wase', who is the legal representative of Dr. Adnan Al-beedh; by a masked group of men on October 9<sup>th</sup>, in front of his house in the city of Al-Mualla.

In such cases, the security apparatus does not bother to investigate in the abduction. For instance, the abduction of Major Nimeiri Abdo Aloudi was reported on November 29<sup>th</sup> by tribal groups in the province of Ma'rib, but the authorities took no action. His body was

later found on December 26<sup>th</sup> in the outskirts of the city of Say'oun, bearing signs of torture and several gunshots<sup>16</sup>.

In an incident which demonstrates the irresponsible manner with which the Authorities' forces act, they admitted that 16 years old Nabil Qahtan was held at their detention facilities, having denied knowing his whereabouts earlier, three days after his abduction on October 21<sup>st</sup>.

#### **5. Torture against the Detainees from the Southern Movement:**

The detainees from the South are systematically subjected to various methods of physical and psychological torture. They face abusive and degrading actions, and many of them died under torture, such as Mohammed Sadiq Khalil who died on February 16<sup>th</sup> after being tortured at a detention facility of the Central Security apparatus in Alsolban, according to his brother's statement to the newspaper Aden Alghad. In addition, citizen Khaled Mohamed Al-azarki died in his prison cell in AlMansoura Central Prison in Aden, on June 20<sup>th</sup>.

Many of the detainees who have been subjected to torture have as a result been afflicted with disabilities and psychic illnesses that are difficult to treat. Yet, they do not receive the necessary treatment to alleviate their suffering from these conditions. The brothers Ma'moun and Mu'tassem Atta' Mahmoud were subjected on October 21<sup>st</sup> to torture and degrading treatment. And 'Alumana' newspaper reported that three young men were tortured on December 18<sup>th</sup> by subjecting them to burns in different parts of their bodies. The three men are Mahmoud Saeed, Talal Abdul Qadir and Firesa Hassan Abdellah (Somali). The injuries resulted from being burnt with heated knives in the neck, wrists and feet, by members of the Central Security apparatus in AlMualla Directorate.

26-year-old Sadiq Ahmed Ali Salem, from the city of al-Hota in the Southern province of Lahj, died on March 18<sup>th</sup> after being arrested by Yemeni security forces. His family says that he has probably been pushed from the top of the security forces building after being subjected to torture. A letter from his brother states that he had seen on his brother's body burns caused by cigarettes, in addition to bruises and blood clots. He further explained that he had probably been thrown down from the top of the detention centre, then taken to the hospital and left in front of it.

The body of martyr Faisal Saleh Abdel Kawi Al-jamai was found in one of the streets in Albraiqa Directorate of Aden, after his abduction following taking part in a peaceful march. His brother Na'ef Aljama'i said that 'the security forces abducted his brother and took him to an unknown location, where he was kept for over a year, before killing him in a brutal manner<sup>17</sup>.

#### **6. Targeting Southern Cities, Villages and Neighbourhoods:**

The Yemeni Government's armed forces turned many cities and villages in the South into military barracks, and offended in the most provocative manner the customs and traditions of conservative families in these regions. They terrorized the locals and disturbed public tranquility. Those forces shoot at houses, urban markets and roads to intimidate the peaceful locals. That has repeatedly occurred in AlHabilayn and Dhali' cities, causing many deaths and casualties, and resulting in damaging many homes, as was the case with Hisham Askar Al-Yafe'i, whose house was destroyed while he was killed inside.

A number of towns and villages in the South suffered of the siege imposed by the Authorities' forces by closing entry ports and creating military check points on the roads, as a collective punishment of their populations. This happened in AlHabilayn, Athmerah, Almallah, AlRuwaid, Assawda, Alqasha, Slic, and Arrabwa. Cutting off electricity and water supply has become a familiar practice, affecting all the locals, particularly those living in coastal areas, especially the cities in Aden Province, where the temperature is often high.

A military force stationed on the heights of AlDali city has on December 4<sup>th</sup> extensively bombarded the city and the surrounding villages using medium-weapons, resulting in killing two people; Khaled Aftyh and Adel Alqsom, and a number of casualties, including children, such as 4 years old Ghalia Ali Mohsen. The Authorities' forces had already implemented a similar operation on September 17<sup>th</sup>, which damaged a number of houses.

On October 5<sup>th</sup>, one person was killed and two others were wounded after an armoured vehicle of Yemeni army stormed into Hashed neighbourhood in AlMansoura city, accompanied by dozens of armed men who opened fire on locals from machine guns.

A military armoured vehicle, which was passing in El-Arish neighbourhood of in Khormaksar area in the evening of Tuesday, March 20<sup>th</sup>, opened fire from machine guns on the houses, which terrorized the locals. The armed forces have repeatedly attacked the residents by opening fire on their homes for no reason.

A group of central security members passed on September 25<sup>th</sup> in the street where AlMansoura prison is located, and shot using DShK (*Dushka*) and machine guns, causing a state of fear among the locals.

A number of citizens in Al-Hota city complained of their houses sustaining damages, in addition to physical and psychological effects on children due to indiscriminate shooting by security personnel using various light and medium weapons, which took place on October 13<sup>th</sup>.

On Sunday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, the Regime's troops went into ElShahid Madram street, which is the main Street in Al-Mualla neighbourhood, accompanied by armoured vehicles, and opened fire on the citizens who had gathered to prevent the troops from entering before meeting their demands regarding detaining those responsible for killing and injuring people from the area during the past few months. As a result of the shooting, two young people were killed; Sameh Mohamed AlYazidi and Nida' Shawki Abdullah, in addition to other sustaining injuries.

Violent explosions took place on November 27<sup>th</sup> in Aden, and they were heard in several areas, including AlMansoura, Sheikh Othman and Dar Saad directorates. Witnesses said that these were because of medium-weapons fired by an army unit that has been stationed in the Caltex roundabout for months, and that they were clearly heard given the calm morning.

In a serious escalation, the Authorities' forces have on Friday, June 15<sup>th</sup>, reinforced with military armored vehicles; broken into Martyrs' Square in AlMansoura Directorate in Aden, which is the square where citizens organize peaceful protests and sit-ins. The forces turned the square into a battlefield as they waged military action against peaceful and unarmed people, who became targets for the snipers, resulting in killing thirteen

people including women and children, while thirty-two people sustained varying injuries<sup>18</sup>.

### **7. Freedom of Press and Free Media:**

One of the things that worry the authorities the most is the Southern press' reports on the crimes committed by the Authorities' forces. Press has therefore faced numerous restrictions and limitations, since it reports and covers the popular protests in the South. Southern journalists are subject to threats, trial or killing. Recently, journalist Fathi bin Lazraq, editor in chief of the website and newspaper 'Aden Alghad', who was summoned for interrogation on the coverage he did of the attacks on AlMansoura city last June, which caused scores of deaths and casualties. The popular 'Alayyam' newspaper remains closed, while its publisher, the late Hisham Bashraheel and his two sons, Mohammed and Hani, face trial, and its keeper, Ahmed Omar Almuraqqashi, was sentenced to death on a trumped-up charge.

Publications are frequently confiscated. This happened to a number of newspapers including Aden Alghad, Attareeq, Alumana', Alqadhiyyah, and other Southern newspapers. The Central Security forces in Aden Abducted AlMaseerah Channel's correspondent, journalist Iyad Imad Ghanem when he entered Assadaqa Hospital in Aden for a professional assignment. Many Southern media workers face harassment and abuse while undertaking their professional duties. Journalist Mohammed Al Yazidi was attacked by the Authorities' forces in AlMukalla city. And a military point of the Central Security Service, stationed at the entrance to AlMukalla city usually confiscates Southern newspapers. 'Aden Alghad' newspaper was confiscated twenty times during September and October only. 'Alqadhiyyah' newspaper considered the threats against its staff, including death threats and threats to amputate their tongues and hands; part of the war that has been ongoing for over 18 years against the South<sup>19</sup>, aiming at eliminating its leadership and the destruction of its wealth. The editor of Alanba' newspaper was summoned on October 3<sup>rd</sup>, to appear before the court.

In the opposite direction, the authorities imposed a media blackout on the Southern Movement's peaceful functions, and try to influence Foreign Media, which led to

widespread dismay in the South, particularly after leading channels ignored the million man march that was organized to commemorate the 49<sup>th</sup> anniversary of October 14<sup>th</sup> Revolution against British colonial rule in South Yemen. As a result of his criticism to this stance, Southern journalist Iyad Qassim Shuaibi faced false accusations and fabricated allegations by journalists affiliated with the Republic of Yemen, which undermined his career and his right to free expression. Furthermore, journalist Saeed Salmeen shkabah was summoned to appear before the public prosecutor for questioning, while activist Nidal Muqbil and her family faced harassment by the Authorities' forces.

### **8. The Absence of Public Tranquillity:**

The Authorities' forces work to establish a chaotic security situation in the Southern provinces through bombings and random shootings to terrify the citizens, as well as through encouraging bearing arms, and disregarding some actions - if not taken at their behest - by some armed groups. Those groups undermine public tranquillity through blocking roads, attacking cars, illegal private and public Land grabbing, and resorting to force. While the citizens condemn such actions, they are aware that the Authorities' themselves stand behind them, aiming at further straining the situation and thus find a justification for further repression and abuse.

The Authorities also seek to worsen the legal situation by encouraging the tribes to revive tribal customs as opposed to legal procedures and provisions, especially those relating to civil and criminal matters. As a result, a number of defendants have been extradited to non-judicial parties that have subsequently killed those individuals extra judicially.

In the event of a dispute between two parties, the Authorities' forces intervenes by taking sides with one party against the other in order to escalate the dispute. This way, a dispute developed into violent clashes in Dar Saad city on November 11<sup>th</sup> between people from Assubaiha and armed men from the province of Dhamar. Two people were killed as a result of the forces fueling the dispute between the two parties.

**The Authorities have also failed** to protect foreign nationals operating in the country. The Swiss citizen Sylvia Ibrhard became a victim of these shortcomings, and the authorities did not interfere since March 15<sup>th</sup> for her release from a group that abducted

her, which holds her as a hostage and a subject of blackmail as they demand a ransom in return of her freedom<sup>20</sup>.

### **Al-Qaeda: A Cat's-Paw of the Authorities**

Senior figures in the Yemeni regime adopted a plan aiming at shuffling the security deck and destabilizing Southern Yemen. This resulted in a deteriorated security situation in many of the Southern provinces, and a number of armed groups emerged, among which one that calls itself 'Ansar Asharee'a Al-Islamiah' *supporters of Islamic Shari'a law* which is an ally of Al Qaeda. Members of these groups operate in a number of provinces, and they took over power in both Ja'ar and Zinjibar towns in Abyan province. With the militias' control of those two cities, they were both turned into battlefields, where scores of civilians have been killed, while infrastructure was destroyed along with people's homes. Terror and panic was widespread among the inhabitants, leading large segments of them to leave their homes and flee to other provinces to save their lives. In addition, the armed forces' use of indiscriminate air strikes and artillery further complicated the deteriorating security situation in this region.

With complete disregard of human rights standards, the Authorities' forces bombarded many homes, thus killing citizens including women and children. On the other hand, armed militias did not exhibit the slightest consideration of humanitarian commitments towards the citizens. This situation resulted in the citizens being trapped between the hammer of the Authorities' forces and the anvil of the armed militias. During Ja'ar city's massacre on August 4<sup>th</sup>, one militiaman affiliated with Al-Qaeda detonated an explosive during mourning rituals taking place in the local community, resulting in 46 people being killed and 48 injured.

Drone attacks caused numerous losses among civilians and terrorized the civilian inhabitants. The Washington Post reported that the number of drone attacks has increased from 18 attacks in the previous year to 53 attacks last year. It is outrageous that the extrajudicial killings resulting from such attacks take place with the Yemeni President's

knowledge and consent<sup>21</sup>. On June 14<sup>th</sup>, an air strike on Shakra city in Abyan province killed four children and a woman, and injured four others, including Hadi Ambat, his wife and two daughters. A nearby house belonging to citizen Alkawwadi was also destroyed, in addition to the house of citizen Al-'amoudi, whose 4 years old son and 6 years old daughter have been killed. Another air strike that took place on June 13<sup>th</sup> on the city of Azzan in Shabwa province led to the destruction of a structural brick-making factory, as well as a nearby house close to Al-Razi clinic, while a mosque sustained damage, too. In addition, an air strike on June 20<sup>th</sup> targeted a group of vehicles that belong to the International Committee of the Red Cross in AlMahfad, and killed a team member, Mr. Hussein Saleh Al Yazidi.

A worrying trend is killings carried out by 'unknown' actors targeting political and military Southern leaders, in order to eliminate those who are believed to have positions opposing to the Yemeni authorities, and to deprive the South of its experienced figures in the event of the South restoring its independent state. These operations are carried out in accordance with what seems to be a deliberate political plan, entailing the use of silent pistol, as well as using explosive devices in the victims' cars, in addition to the use of motorbikes, all done with a capacity to hide and camouflage. At least 10 people have been victims of such criminal operations during the past year; a number which, combined with the number of victims of similar operations in previous years, adds up to more than 63 operations, according to sources in the Southern Movement. During that year, the victims include Major General Salem Qotton, Major General Omar Barashid, Major General Nasser Al Mahdi Farid al-Awlaki, Brigadier General Fadel Jaber Alradfani, Brigadier General Gibran Hassan Ashabhy, and others. The Southern Movement holds the Yemeni Authorities responsible for these assassinations, and considers it a plot to liquidate Southern leadership<sup>22</sup>.

A health report issued by Almesenah hospital in Shabwa suggests that the death of 50 people of cancer may be due to exposure to radioactive materials as a result of air strikes carried out by U.S. and Yemeni military aircrafts on the region against members of Al-Qaeda. The report which was published by the news website, Almasdar Online on March

7<sup>th</sup> states that these air strikes ‘have caused the dissemination of dangerous chemical radiations.. and that remnants of the rockets fired from aircraft on a number of areas contributed to the increased cancer incidence rates’, noting that a number of other people who suffer from the same illness were transferred abroad, while others receive treatment in public hospitals in some provinces.

To clarify the facts related to this matter, it is perhaps indicative to point out that one of the former ministers in the Yemeni Regime revealed that the Regime was not serious about combating terrorism, as it serves a dual purpose; on the one hand, it can be used to eliminate the peaceful Southern Movement, and on the other, it is a pretext to perpetuate the concerns about the threat from Al Qaeda in neighbouring countries as well as the West, in his own words<sup>23</sup>.

### **National and International Recommendations**

The Southern Observatory for Human Rights, as it reviews some aspects of the Yemeni Government’s shameful human rights record in the South of Yemen, draws attention to the alarming outcomes of the human rights situation in that region and the grave abuses committed against its citizens. The Observatory therefore **calls upon the Yemeni Government** to:

1. Put an end to its oppressive policies towards the citizens of Southern Yemen, and to take decisive action against the perpetrators of human rights violations, bringing them to justice with a view to holding them accountable for their crimes. The Government is reminded of its responsibility towards the state of lawlessness and security disorder that prevails in all provinces of the South, and the threats and dangers this poses to stability and public order.
2. To ratify the First Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, which provides for humanitarian organizations, individuals and victims of human rights violations to report and file complaints to the international mechanisms mandated to protect human rights.
3. Not to authorize drones launching raids on the territory of the South, as those operations result in the killing of innocent citizens, especially considering that there is no

legal justification for such actions and given that the Yemeni military can implement its plans without resorting to this form of actions.

**On the international level:**

1. The Southern Observatory for Human Rights calls upon the international community, through the United Nations Human Rights Council, to establish an international mechanism that can put an end to human rights violations committed in Southern Yemen and protect its citizens from abuses targeting their political and civil rights.

2. The Observatory calls upon the United Nations High Commission to open a field office in the city of Aden to provide a platform for closely monitoring the grave violations committed against the People of the South. It also calls upon the Commission to include the state of human rights in Southern Yemen in its periodic reports to the United Nations Human Rights Council, and draws the Commission’s attention to the fact that the Yemeni Government has failed to fulfill its commitments regarding the implementation of the Council’s resolution on investigating human rights violations; the Observatory therefore proposes that this task be undertaken by an independent international commission.

3. The Southern Observatory calls upon the United Nations Human Rights Council to denounce the ‘Immunity Code’ which immunizes the former Yemeni President and his regime from prosecution for the grave human rights violations they committed in Southern Yemen; as this law is incompatible with the international law provisions on the protection of human rights.

4. The Southern Observatory calls upon the United Nations Human Rights Council to appoint a special rapporteur on human rights in Yemen, with a view to conduct periodic assessments to the Yemeni Government’s record and examine the cases of abuse targeting the People of the South.
