

This may Certify that the Wife of Morris Fitzgerald, has faithfully nursed, washed, and taken care of all the Sick of Col Lopez's Regiment, as also those of Forts Washington, & Sullivan, that have been carried to the Hospital on Adams's Island, as also a number of Sick belonging to three Companies lately raised and marched for Providence, and also three Men belonging to an armed Schooner brought in by Capt Pinckon one of which tarried three months in the Hospital, the whole of which amounting, at least to 40 Patients. That she has not received any pay or compensation for her services since October 1776
