Dave.

As you know, it has been over a year since we started the initial discussions with SCE and the Department to get approvals for temporary installs of cameras on SCE poles. Since I have been at the ASAP unit (over 10 years) SCE and Cal Trans have never allowed law enforcement to install camera equipment on their utility poles or light standards until now. This Master Agreement addresses utilizing SCE poles or light standards to install cameras in areas that could benefit from such deployments.

I am glad to say after this rather lengthy process and some minor language changes, as well as addressing any concerns from SCE and the CEO's office the agreement has finally been signed and approved by the CEO's office and SCE for the Department. I am providing you a copy of the agreement as well as the application process. This has been a lengthy process, as utilities have not wanted us to "hang cameras" on their poles, but this now provides us a formalized way to get permission for "short term" installations on SCE equipment.
