Just so that we are on the same page, the ALPR cameras cost \$15,000 per camera with a \$40 monthly charge. Construction/installation costs would come out to about \$1,000 to \$5,000. Times everything by two and you would have the costs for two ALPR cameras.

Sounds like my Council Members have been chatting with Margret Finley, and she's been providing substantially lower costs. I want to make sure we are speaking the same financial language.
