Brian,

That's great to here! I have cc'd (Greg Mills from Vigilant Solutions) who is the sales representative for Vigilant. He (Greg) will just need your city's purchasing agent to work with him on the details of the Purchase Order or other methods the city handles purchasing (previous quote attached).

Greg will need to provide specifications of the size of the cement pad needed and any electrical questions to your city staff on how the electrical will run into the box. It may be useful to have the conduit and electrical run to the (2) specific sites and have the cement pad poured with electrical connections already built into the pad. I would suggest maybe a quick trip down to the site just to make sure we are all on the same page and we haven't missed anything needed for the installation. Vigilant has a technician that is local so he can easily get down there to meet with city staff doing the installation and prepping for the pad.

Remember you will also need a SIM card for the cellular lines for each device, so (2) cell lines will be needed. Do you know who the city's wireless carrier is? We usually use Verizon for most of our fixed installs and need to make sure the SIM card for the carrier would be compatible with the GX450 router that is to be used.

Here is my suggestions:

Budget person reach out to Vigilant

Check on city wireless carrier

Schedule a site walk with Vigilant, city maintenance, and ASAP

City begin pad installation

Vigilant and ASAP provide equipment and technical support in the setup

City acquire cell lines for both devices

Complete installation and test

ASAP work with Temple Station to provide alerts/training
