Next week at our Council meeting, we are going to be discussing potentially shifting our Emergency Response Committee (which just does disaster preparedness) to more of an informal Public Safety Committee. There are a lot of thoughts out there, but this shift is still in its infancy stages.

One of the ideas here is to have a Deputy service Bradbury a few times a months for a few hours to be at the PS Committee meetings, and chat with residents about Neighborhood Watch. Ultimately, it would be nice to have a LASD liaison to the Committee, but it would be VERY minimal hours. Since the workload is so low, it doesn't make sense to have a full time or even a part time deputy.

I recently was told that Duarte has two special deputies that deal with Duarte's PS Commission and other neighborhood watch type programs. Do you think Duarte might have an interest if Bradbury paid for something like 10 hour a month toward Duarte's full-timer just to help with our low intensive program?

We are all in the infant stages of discovering what we want to do, but I had this idea that I wanted to at least throw out there.
