2. Discussion - City Council Liaisons for Fiscal Year 2013/2014 Consideration of Resolution No. 14-10 and 14-11; Pertaining to the appointments to the LA Sanitation District and California Joint Powers Insurance Authority

This forecast represents the opportunity for City Council to review the financial picture before a study session in May to receive public input on the proposed FY 2014-15 Budget. Following this meeting, staff will complete any necessary changes and bring the budget back before the City Council for approval. Staff recommends that the City Council review the proposed draft budget forecast and provide staff with input and direction to prepare the draft budget.

5. Discussion – Approval of the City's Legislative Platform for the Proposed Legislative Scorecard

The City of Bradbury regularly monitors and discusses positions on legislative proposals generated at the county, state, and federal levels or on issues that affect the community as a whole. From time to time the City meets with its local representatives to discuss these matters, and it was suggested that the City develop a legislation scorecard to follow-up on the City's representatives and their actions or inactions on matters of interest. It is recommended that the City Council discuss this item and provide further direction to staff.

RESOLUTION NO. 14-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADBURY, CALIFORNIA, ALLOCATING FUNDS FROM THE CITIZEN'S OPTION FOR PUBLIC SAFETY ("COPS") PROGRAM, AND DOCUMENTING THE DETERMINATIONS REQUIRED BY THE SUPPLEMENTAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

Whereas, the City of Bradbury receives funds pursuant to Assembly Bill 3229 of 1996, commonly known as the Brulte Bill or the Citizen's Option for Public Safety ("COPS") Program; and

Whereas, the City of Bradbury currently has a budget allocation of \$100,000 in COPS funding for Fiscal Year 2013-2014; and

Whereas, all cities which receive COPS must allocate the funds and account for these allocations through an oversight process coordinated by the Supplemental Law Enforcement Oversight Committee ("SLEOC") of the County of Los Angeles; and

Whereas, this resolution will confirm and document decisions made during the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 budget process.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADBURY DOES HEREBY FIND AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council allocates a portion of its COPS funds as follows:

LA County Sherriff's Department (Duarte/Bradbury Special Assignment Deputy)	\$50,000
LA County Sherriff's Department (for City of Bradbury)	\$16,814.25
Total amount allocated	\$66,814.25

Section 2. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution.



SUBJECT: SUPPLEMENTAL ENFORCEMENT FOR THE CITY OF BRADBURY

The city of Bradbury has requested supplemental enforcement in the amount of \$66,814.25 from the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department. The city of Bradbury resolution number 14-08, along with check #12923 in the amount of \$66,814.25, is enclosed. These funds will be distributed for additional traffic and patrol enforcement for the city of Bradbury in the amount of \$16,814.25 and a Special Assignment Deputy for Duarte/Bradbury area in the amount of \$50,000. The funds are to be utilized and/or distributed only by Temple Station.

It should be noted that these funds may not be fully expended by the end of this fiscal year 2013/2014; therefore, they should be established in "trust" and, ultimately, all remaining funds at the end of this fiscal year should "roll over" to the next fiscal year.

We are requesting the funding be deposited into the city of Bradbury Trust Account # TK7-7364 as soon as possible.
