The Pre-1611 Bibles give a total of 25 matches with the AV1611 out of a possible 28 or 89%. The Pre-1611 Bibles underlie the 16th Century English Reformation. The Pre-1611 readings clearly converge on the AV1611. The AV1611 emphasise salvation through faith in Christ.
