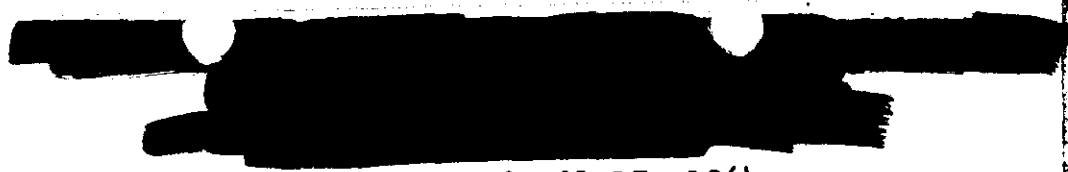

Dear Mr. Hoover:

The Associated Press on the occasion of the one-day visit to Indiana by Governor George C. Wallace Governor of Alabama on April 15, reports that Governor Matthew E. Welsh said of Governor Wallace:

"This is the man whose beliefs were responsible for the deaths of innocent children in the bombing of a Sunday School class."

The statement refers, ofcourse, to the bombing of the Negro Church in Birmingham last summer resulting in the death of two or three Negro children. This statement is only the latest, regular, seemingly unending use of this unsolved, heinous crime to slur, indict and condemn people of the entire south, not Alabama alone, collectively or individually as the occasion may dictate.

The news media at the time of this particular bombing, as well as most of the many others that have occurred in Birmingham in recent years, reported that the FBI was investigating but so far as the public is informed neither this particular bombing nor any of the others have been solved.

This situation is conspicuously mystifying when one notes that similar crimes in other areas of the nation have been and are being solved by the FBI with expediency and apparent ease. The latest example of this is the Florida East Coast Railroad bombings and the bombing of a Negro home in Jacksonville, Fla.

No criticism, direct or implied, is here intended of the FBI. The institution you head is the finest in Washington - barring none. I realize that you cannot in any way control the use others make of the incidents here described. But if there is any information you may properly give me as to why the FBI has been unable to solve any of these Birmingham bombings it will certainly be appreciated.

Based on the recent on-the-spot analysis of racial bombing matters in your office, you are authorized to conduct surveys for the purpose of determining the feasibility of microphone coverage on the following places:

[REDACTED]

This should be handled in a prompt, discreet manner and appropriate recommendations made to the Bureau.

Eventual consideration should be given to the secondary targets discussed with you, depending on the productivity of the installation on the primary targets. In connection with these surveys consideration should be given to discreetly determining the vacation plans of the afore-mentioned individuals inasmuch as the vacation season is approaching.

Upon the development of additional data you should continue to bear in mind the eventual possibility of bringing some of the "action" group before an investigating grand jury, particularly the fringe group who may have information concerning these bombings. This may be the medium needed to have them cooperate with the Government. You should also consider the possibilities and potentialities of catching some of the Klan "action" squad in the act of committing violence. Before taking any action on either of these two courses you should, of course, communicate with the Bureau and obtain its evaluation and authority.

You are instructed to immediately activate the other ~~two~~ bombing cases you had under investigation. The two bombings which occurred on Center Street within minutes of each other may be worked out of ~~one~~ case as they apparently were perpetrated by the same individuals at the same time.

While the Bureau has the greatest possible interest in solving the bombing of the 16th Street Baptist Church in view of the four deaths involved, nevertheless it is expected that the other bombings will also receive vigorous investigative attention. Some of the suspects in these bombings, while possibly not participating in the bombing of the Baptist Church, might nevertheless possess possible valuable information as to the church bombing as they are part of the same

Klan "action" group. The solution of one of these other bombings might be just the lever we need to solve the church bombing. You are also instructed to re-institute the practice of submitting a daily teletype on the Baptist Church bombing and a weekly airtel summary on each of the other bombings.

You are being authorized to utilize a Relief Supervisor fifty percent of his time on your desk in order that you may devote at least fifty percent of your supervisory time to these major cases. This should give sufficient time to enable you to provide the necessary imaginative, vigorous and ingenious approach which is imperative if we are to solve these cases. The Bureau desires that you assign eight Agents of your office to the bombing cases and they are not to be used on other assignments except on emergencies and then only with Bureau approval. If you need additional manpower upon the successful installation of the aforementioned microphones, you should further communicate with the Bureau.

In order to facilitate and intensify your coverage at odd hours and on weekends, you are authorized to have Agents work odd-hour shifts and adjusted work weeks as needed. You should be sure Agents work at least five days between Sunday and Saturday of each week.

In order to facilitate surveillances on Klansmen, which must be discreet, you are authorized to rent automobiles from appropriate rental agencies. You are being furnished four portable two-way radios for communications purposes in these rented cars.

b2c, d The Bureau realizes that you have recently developed some very good information from [REDACTED] and you should continue to fully exploit this source. However, it is not felt that you have sufficient live informant coverage on the "action" group at the Eastview and Bessemer Klaverns. Maximum efforts must be made to increase this coverage, and you should immediately take the necessary steps to work other individuals into a position where they can furnish information on the activities of this group. You should continue to intensively investigate [REDACTED]

In answer to Bureau's questions relative to the occupancy of this dwelling, it is noted that numerous spot checks have been made, both in daylight and night hours. No instance has been noted wherein the dwelling was not occupied during the night hours. These spot checks have also developed that there are individuals in the neighborhood who are apparently lookouts for occupants. It has not been deemed advisable to attempt entry during daylight hours for this reason.

Relative to the misur becoming inoperative, Agents have on several occasions attempted to gain entrance to the dwelling on pretext of interview but have not been admitted by occupants.

BACKGROUND:

By letter dated April 8, 1964, President Lyndon B. Johnson inquired concerning the status of the Birmingham bombings. He was appropriately advised on April 10, 1964, and Mr. Rosen recommended, and it was approved, that I proceed to the scene to determine whether there are any additional pressure points that can be brought to bear and to assure that all possible steps to solve these cases are being taken. Mr. Tolson instructed that all 6 bombings we are investigating in Birmingham be looked into.

RESULTS OF INQUIRY:

A thorough review was made into all aspects of the 6 unsolved bombings and it was the Inspector's conclusion that all of these cases have been given a most vigorous and intensive investigation. Thousands of persons have been interviewed, a great many ingenious techniques were used to solve these cases without success to date. All of the investigation conducted to date indicates strongly that all 6 bombings were probably perpetrated by members of the Eastview Klavern of the Ku Klux Klan (KKK) with possible assistance of several individuals from the Bessemer, Alabama, Klavern. Approximately 16 men from these two groups form a select hard core "action" group who are undoubtedly responsible for personal violence and bombings against Negroes in this area for a long period of time.

Inspector feels that there is a good possibility that we would have already solved some of these bombings had it not been for the interference of the Alabama Highway Patrol, the Birmingham City Police, and the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office. They not only arrested several of the key suspects at a most inopportune time, but they were extremely crude in placing technical coverage on the various suspects. In fact, they were so crude that they were caught climbing telephone poles to put on wire taps; one installation that they put under the seat in a suspect's car promptly rolled out by the suspect's feet

This, of course, has seriously hampered our investigation.

We have interviewed and reinterviewed the suspects and their associates to the point where we are getting practically nothing from them. In fact, most of them will not even talk to us. Spot surveillances of the Klansmen have been unproductive and Inspector feels at this time that they are familiar with most of our cars in this area. While we have received some very worthwhile information from informants, we do not have enough coverage of the "action" group. There have been no bombings or other violence since September 25, 1963, undoubtedly partly as a result of investigative pressure. However, there are indications that the "action" group of the Klan is getting bolder.

The local authorities, both city and state, have reduced their investigative activity concerning the bombings to a minimum. Inspector feels that there must be a fresh approach at this time and we should attempt to place microphone coverage on as many of the key suspects who are members of the Klan "action" squad as possible as well as on the Eastview and Bessemer Klavern meeting halls.

[REDACTED] Microphone coverage would have to be without the knowledge of the telephone company as we cannot trust their employees because of their sympathy to the Klan.

Inspector has made on-the-scene tour of the area around suspects' residences and Klavern meeting places and microphone coverage appears feasible in most instances. Birmingham Office has also been advised that it is imperative to increase efforts to obtain additional live coverage on "action" group. During instant inquiry Inspector noted [REDACTED]

The envisioned increased microphone coverage should enable us to obtain a great deal more information concerning the day-to-day activities of the "action" group. Inspector feels that with the additional data we undoubtedly will obtain together with the information we have, that we should continue to give consideration to eventually having some of the Klan "action" group subpoenaed before an investigating

Grand Jury as well as "fringe members" close to the "action" group who appear to be on the edges of the conspiracy but not directly involved in the bombings, yet apparently in possession of valuable information.

Inspector feels that with additional coverage it may even be possible to catch some of the Klan "action" squad in the act of committing violence such as we did in solving the Florida train bombings recently. If this is not feasible we must at least place ourselves in the position where we are aware of new bombings and take appropriate preventative action.

At the present time all 6 bombings are being worked out of one case, i. e., bombing of the 16th Street Baptist Church. This was done with Bureau approval on the theory that the suspects in the Baptist Church bombing were the same as those in the other bombings. At one time this may have been desirable, but at the present time Inspector feels this is highly undesirable. Subsequent investigation has disclosed that while there are some instances where the same individual may possibly have participated in several bombings, there are other instances where different individuals of the Klan "action" squad apparently participated in the different bombings.

The office has naturally concentrated on the key suspects of the Baptist Church bombing wherein the 4 little girls were killed. However, by doing this the investigation on some of the logical suspects in the other 5 bombings have more or less drifted and lost intensity. Inspector feels these cases should be worked separately and investigation of these 5 bombings intensified.

The Birmingham Office had been submitting a daily teletype summary to the Bureau up until 3/12/64. They are now submitting a weekly summary. In order to intensify the pressure on this case and provide for closer supervision, Inspector feels that Birmingham should be required to submit a daily summary on the Baptist Church bombing and a weekly airtel summary on the other bombings.

When special squad in Birmingham, we had SAC Roy Moore of Little Rock, devoting full time to this case. SAC Faisst in Birmingham has over 400 cases on his desk, including the bombing cases, together with the bulk of the public relations, personnel responsibilities, etc. Inspector does not feel Faisst can provide necessary leadership, guidance and impetus to the 6 bombing cases with such a heavy work load. Inspector feels Faisst should be authorized to use Relief Supervisor on his desk 50% of each day and that Faisst be required to spend 50% of his time supervising and providing the necessary imaginative, vigorous and ingenious approach on these 6 bombings so that they will be solved.

An equivalency of 4 Agents have been working on instant bombings for the past 2 months. With the return of 2 men from special assignment, the office contemplated assigning 6 men to these bombings. Manpower analysis conducted

during recently completed inspection reflects that two additional men can be made available from general criminal assignment to work on the bombing cases. This makes a total of 8 men available from the Birmingham Office to work on these bombings. If proposed technical coverage approved, it will be necessary to monitor these from individual rather than from a consolidated plant, which requires considerable manpower. Eventually the Birmingham Office may need 4 additional men if the microphones are installed. Inspector does not feel any additional manpower should be transferred into Birmingham until we are certain the microphone installations will be made. [REDACTED] Approximately \$30,000 worth of reward money for solution of Baptist Church bombing is outstanding, and Birmingham instructed to make full use of this fact in handling the investigation.

Inspector feels that these bombing cases will undoubtedly only be solved if we can get one or more of the conspirators to confess or obtain sufficient admissions re bombings which suspects have made to close associates and relatives. Inspector advised SAC and Agents working on this case that the reputation of the FBI depends on their ability to solve this case and no matter what the obstacles and problems are, and in spite of all the negative investigation conducted, they must not become discouraged or adopt a defeatist attitude. The Brinks case was cited as an outstanding example where FBI persistence and ingenuity under similarly trying circumstances paid off. I informed them that the Director and the President expect them to bring these cases to a solution.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

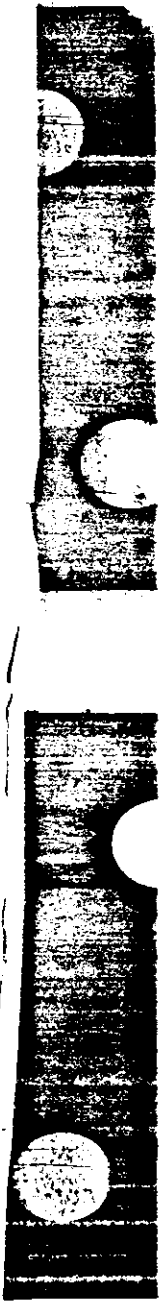

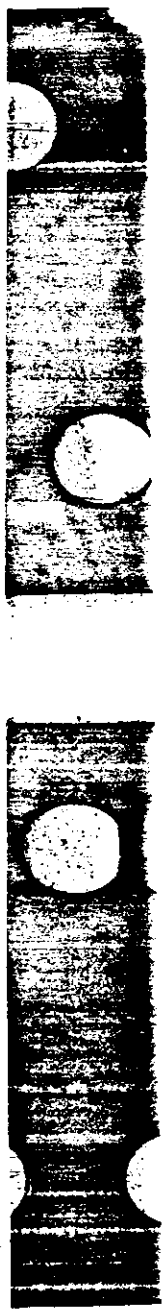

In connection with the attached Washington Post article captioned "FBI Knows Church Bombers In Birmingham, Writer Says," which appears on page A3 of the May 30, 1964, issue, we have received many calls from news services. All callers have been answered with a strict "no comment." It appears that a free-lance writer, "George McMillan," who has written for the Saturday Evening Post in the past, is the author of several books, has talked considerably with United States Attorney Weaver at Birmingham, whom he quotes in the magazine article. The article points out that the FBI is aware that one man is responsible for the September, 1963, bombing of the Birmingham church in which 4 Negro girls were killed. It states the FBI is aware of the identity of other persons involved but it has not been possible for the FBI to arrest those responsible because of lack of evidence.

The article in both the Saturday Evening Post and the Associated Press wire story printed by the Washington Post this morning is not unfavorable to the FBI.

Early this year, McMillan, the author of the story, contacted several of our field offices as well as Bureau Headquarters and we told him we could not be of assistance to him. We are, of course, continuing to "no comment" all aspects of this matter.

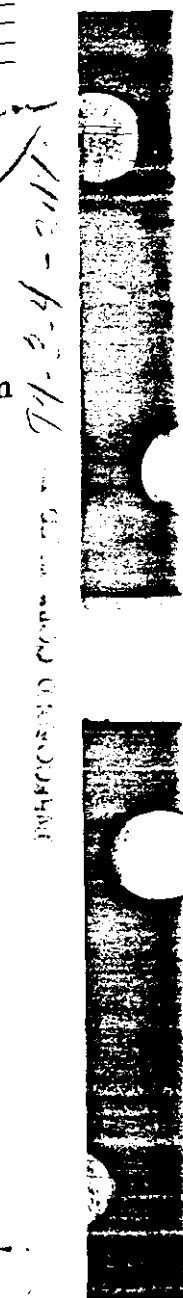

NEW YORK.--POLICE AND FEDERAL AGENTS KNOW THE IDENTITY OF THE BIRMINGHAM BOMBER AND THE MEN WHO HELPED HIM DYNAMITE A NEGRO CHURCH KILLING FOUR YOUNG GIRLS, IT WAS REPORTED TODAY.

THE RINGLEADER OF THE GANG OF KILLERS, KNOWN AS "MISTER X," HAS NOT BEEN TAKEN INTO CUSTODY BECAUSE OFFICIALS DO NOT FEEL THEY HAVE ENOUGH EVIDENCE TO PUT HIM AND HIS HENCHMEN IN THE ELECTRIC CHAIR OR BEHIND BARS, THE CURRENT ISSUE OF THE SATURDAY EVENING POST REPORTED.

"THE FBI KNOWS WHO BOUGHT THE DYNAMITE, WHO MADE THE BOMB, WHO PLACED IT THERE, AND WHO ENGINEERED THE CRIME," MACON WEAVER, U.S. ATTORNEY IN BIRMINGHAM, WAS QUOTED AS SAYING.

"WE KNOW EVERY DETAIL ABOUT IT, BUT WE JUST DON'T HAVE THE EVIDENCE," SAID LT. MAURICE HOUSE, CHIEF OF BIRMINGHAM DETECTIVES, ACCORDING TO THE ARTICLE.

HOUSE DECLINED TO DISCUSS THE ARTICLE TODAY AND NEITHER THE FBI OR THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE WOULD COMMENT ON IT.

IT WAS ON A SUNNY SUNDAY MORNING LAST SEPT. 12, JUST AS SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES WERE GETTING OUT, THAT THE DYNAMITE BOMB PLANTED UNDER THE STAIRS AT THE 16TH STREET BAPTIST CHURCH EXPLODED, HURLING RUBBLE FOR BLOCKS IN THE NEGRO SECTION OF THE VIOLENCE-ROCKED ALABAMA CITY.

THE BLAST KILLED FOUR YOUNG NEGRO GIRLS AND INJURED 19 PERSONS. IT WAS ONE OF MANY EXPLOSIONS THAT HAVE KEPT RACIAL TENSIONS AT A FEVER PITCH FOR MONTHS.

BUT IT WAS THE ONE THAT SHOCKED THE NATION AS NOTHING ELSE HAD AND CAUSED PRESIDENT KENNEDY TO SAY HE FELT A "DEEP SENSE OF OUTRAGE AND GRIEF."

THE MAGAZINE SAID THAT 10 DAYS AFTER THE CHURCH BOMBING, THE KILLERS STRUCK AGAIN--THIS TIME WITH A PAIR OF BOMBS DESIGNED TO KILL POLICEMEN AND DETECTIVES WHO WERE MAKING THINGS UNCOMFORTABLE FOR THEM BY PROBING INTO THEIR ACTIVITIES.

THE FIRST BOMB, PROBABLY ONE STICK OF DYNAMITE, WAS SET OFF IN A VACANT LOT. POLICE RUSHED TO THE SCENE, BUT COULD NOT LOCATE IT IMMEDIATELY. THE SECOND BOMB, DYNAMITE IN A CAN FILLED WITH RUSTY SHRAPNEL, WENT OFF 13 MINUTES AFTER THE FIRST.

"IT WAS MEANT FOR US," A POLICEMAN WAS QUOTED AS SAYING. "IT WAS SET TO ALLOW JUST ENOUGH TIME FOR US TO GET THERE. IF WE HAD FOUND THE BOMB, MAYBE 50 OFFICERS WOULD HAVE LOST THEIR LIVES OR BEEN MANAGLED."

THE ARTICLE SAID FBI AGENTS FEEL THAT STATE POLICE CHIEF COL. AL LINGO "SERIOUSLY HURT THE CHANCES OF BUILDING A CASE" AGAINST THE BOMBER AND HIS GANG BY ARRESTING TWO MEN WHO HAD BEEN INVOLVED IN KU KLUX KLAN ACTIVITIES.

THE MEN, R. E. CHAMBLISS, 59, AND CHARLES CAGLE, 22, BOTH OF BIRMINGHAM, WERE CHARGED WITH ILLEGAL POSSESSION OF DYNAMITE AND SUBSEQUENTLY WERE CONVICTED, FINED \$100 EACH AND SENTENCED TO 180 DAYS IN JAIL.

THE MAGAZINE SAID THE FBI CONSIDERED IT A PREMATURE ARREST WHICH TIPPED OFF THE BOMBERS THAT AUTHORITIES KNEW A GREAT DEAL ABOUT THEIR ACTIVITIES BUT ALSO SHOWED THEY DID NOT HAVE ENOUGH EVIDENCE TO CONVICT THEM OF THE CHURCH BOMBING.

TO PREVENT ANY OF THE GANG FROM TALKING, THE MAGAZINE SAID, A "KISS OF DEATH MEETING" WAS HELD WITH ALL OF THE GROUP INVOLVED IN THE BOMBING ATTENDING.

"IF ANY ONE OF YOU EVER TALKS, IT WILL BE THE KISS OF DEATH FOR YOU," THE RINGLEADER, MISTER X, WAS REPORTED AS VOWING. "WE JOIN HANDS HERE AND NOW IN SWEARING THAT EACH OF US TAKES A VOW TO KILL THE MAN WHO GIVES ANYTHING AWAY TO THE POLICE."

THE MAGAZINE SAID THAT DETECTIVES AND FEDERAL AGENTS FOLLOW "MISTER X" CONSTANTLY. HE KNOWS THEY ARE FOLLOWING HIM AND SOMETIMES SPITS AT THEM AND YELLS "YOU HOGS" AT THEM.

THE BOMBER IS BEING SO CAREFUL NOW, THE MAGAZINE SAID, THAT OFFICIALS HAVE LITTLE HOPE THEY CAN CONVICT HIM OF MURDER. THEY HAVE MORE HOPE OF PINNING A CONSPIRACY CHARGE ON HIM.

"YOU'VE PRETTY NEARLY GOT TO HAVE SOMEBODY WHO WAS AT THE MEETING WHEN IT WAS PLANNED," WEAVER WAS QUOTED AS SAYING. "AND JUST REMEMBER THAT THE PEOPLE WHO DID THIS ARE GOING TO THE CHAIR."

BUT AN FBI OFFICIAL SAID "WE WILL GET HIM. HE'LL MAKE HIS MISTAKE. WE'RE GOING TO SOLVE THIS CASE IF IT TAKES TEN YEARS."

FBI Reportedly Knows Birmingham Bomber

NEW YORK, May 30 (AP).—The Saturday Evening Post reported yesterday that FBI officials know who planted the explosive that killed four young Negro girls in a Birmingham (Ala.) church last September, but don't have enough evidence for a conviction.

"Law enforcement officials know who the bomber and his accomplices are—have known for months," the Post reported. "But they have not been able to put together the kind of an airtight case they need to take 'Mister X' to court."

In Birmingham, FBI Agent Ray Falst said his office would have no comment on the article. Birmingham Police Chief Jamie Moore could not be reached for comment.

Officials stated recently, however, that they were continuing to check out all leads in what has been one of the most intensive investigations in Birmingham history.

No Charges Made

No one has been charged with any of Birmingham's racial bombings—more than 40 since World War II. Three white men were arrested in September and convicted on charges of illegal possession of dynamite, but prosecution attempts to link them with bombings were futile. The men have appealed their convictions.

The Post report said police and FBI officials, who have been conducting an intensive investigation since the September 15, 1963, tragedy at the Sixteenth Street Baptist Church, have enough evidence to believe that the 'Mister X':

Planned the . . . bombing at a meeting in Birmingham two weeks before it happened.

Was at the house of the men

who planted the bomb two nights before the bombing.

"His car was parked two blocks away from the church on the Sunday morning the bomb went off."

"Mister X" is under constant surveillance, the Post report, by George McMillan, quoted a police official as saying.

Hates Police

"Of course," the official was quoted, "we can't literally stay with him 24 hours a day . . . but we put him to bed every night and check him first thing every morning . . . he hates us, but he hates the FBI even worse. . . ."

Mr. McMillan wrote that police told him "Mister X" makes almost his entire living from doing jobs for hate movements, but has never been found at the scene of the Birmingham bombing.

"He has a distinguishing physical characteristic," a detective was quoted as saying.

The report said that "at a time and place that cannot yet be revealed, a group of men including the man who made the bomb, the man who placed it and everyone who knew the identities of those involved met."

"If any one of you ever talks," Mr. McMillan quoted the leader of the meeting as saying, "it will be the kiss of death for you. . . . We join hands here and now in swearing that each of us takes a vow to kill the man who gives anything away to the police."

"And they weren't kidding, either," a policeman was reported to have said.

Bragged Openly

"There was a time when they used to brag more or less openly about these bombings. But it finally got through their heads that some of them might pay a fearful damned price for running around blowing people up."

The Post said evidence collected at the scene indicates the bomb was planted in advance and detonated by some kind of timing device, probably not an ordinary fuse.

The "Mister X" was described as a man who "hates the FBI" so much he sometimes doubles back and yells "you hogs" at tailing agents.

"We will get him . . ." an FBI official is quoted as saying, "He'll make his mistake. We're going to solve this case if it takes ten years."

Mr. McMillan's story appears in the Saturday Evening Post's June 6 issue. He has lived in South Carolina for 20 years, and is "an authority on policing integration disturbances," the Post said.

On October 30, 1963, JERRY DUTTON of NATIONAL STATES RIGHTS PARTY Headquarters, 1865 Bessemer Road, Birmingham, contacted the Birmingham Police Department and reported that there were two Communists at NSRP Headquarters and that he would like to have the Birmingham Police Department come out and get them. The Birmingham Police Department responded to the call and determined that there were not two Communists, but two Special Agents of the FBI, namely, SA [redacted], of the Houston Office, and [redacted], of the Little Rock Office, at the scene. As a result, JERRY DUTTON was arrested by the Birmingham Police for furnishing false information to the Police Department. At a subsequent trial in Recorder's Court, DUTTON was found guilty and fined. His attorney, MATT MURPHY, appealed the case to the Jefferson County Circuit Court.

On June 1, 1964, Birmingham Office received two subpoenas issued by Jefferson County Circuit Court requesting appearance of SA [redacted] and [redacted] in that court at 9 a.m., 6-3-64, for testimony in the case involving the City of Birmingham vs JERRY DUTTON.

SA [redacted] contacted Assistant City Attorney WILLIAM WALKER concerning the subpoenas and the necessity for the appearance of the Agents.
