



BIBLE CLASS FOR COUNTRY WOMEN.

Pyeng Yang, Korea. March 1930.

Enrollment 1184 plus about 200 floating sisters who did not attend regularly.

Course of five years covers early parts of Old and New Testaments.

Sixth year course added for those who have completed five year course. This course covers epistles and prophecies changing each year.

Class held for eleven days including Sunday.

Each class was subdivided according to age: girls, young women, middle aged, old. Two or three divisions according to need gave sixteen divisions or thirty two periods daily.

No city women allowed, have separate class earlier.

Sunrise prayer meeting 6 A.M.

Morning prayers 10 A.M.

Study periods 11 A.M. and 1:30

Afternoon classes in reading, writing, arithmetic and Chinese.
