CRUCIAN[KARAS'][ii] reports that all the captains of Yugoslav merchant ships have received from SIDON[iii] written instructions signed by a former vice-director of the Bank of Yugoslavia, RUDOLF BICANICRUDOL'F BICHANICH] [5 groups unrecovered] [B% to raise] the flag of TITO on the ships, [2 groups unrecovered] [D% port] to get in touch with BICANIC and await instructions from him. B. calls himself a representative of the liberation movement.

[O% The text] [8 groups unrecoverable] did not oure[a] RUDIC[RUDICH]"[iv]. Is B. acting upon instructions from TITO, or is this provocation?
