PREFACE

This report gives the final figures for agriculture from the 1945 Census of Newfoundland. These tabulations have been carried out in the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at the request of Newfoundland. The present report gives data by Census District on the number cultivating land; the condition of land; area, production, and sales of crops; farm machinery and equipment; live stock and products. A number of historical tables are also included.

The values, including sales, of the respective crops, classes of live stock and animal products given in this report are calculated from average prices prevailing at the date of the census, except for enquiries relating to the value of production and sales of beets, carrots and fruits. (See Appendix "A".)

Further reports are being compiled to give data on agriculture by settlement, as well as data relating to fisheries, households and families, and population classified by occupations, industry, income, etc.

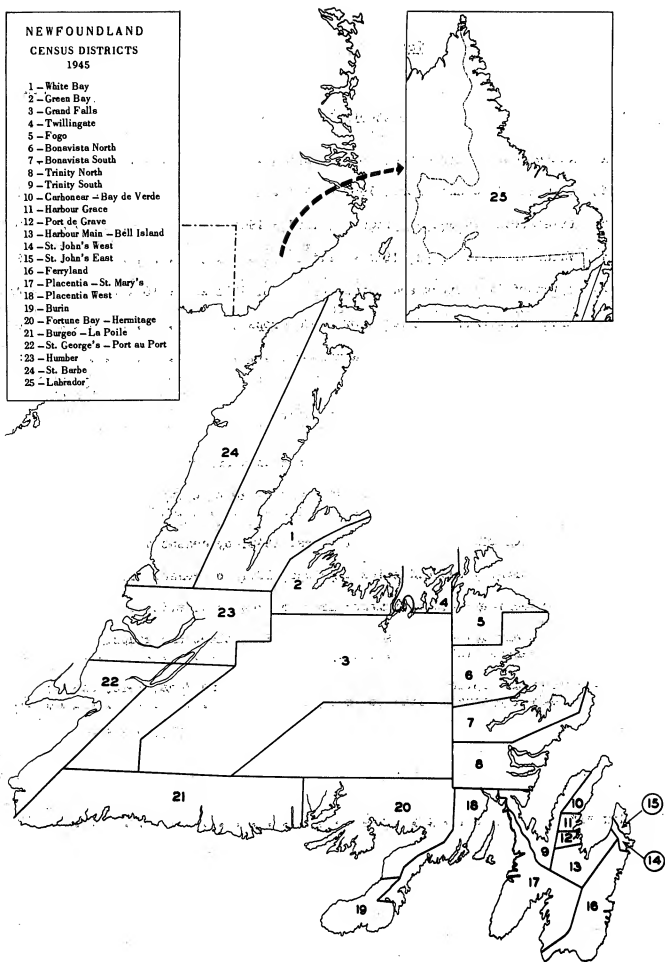
