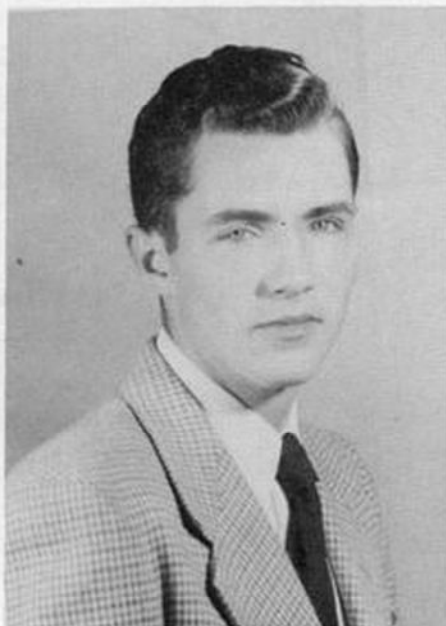

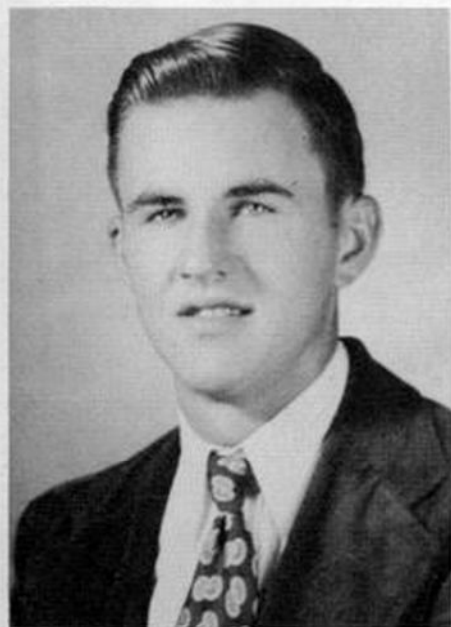

Class History

The Class of 1952 first began its four year high school term in Hillsboro High School in 1948 under the direction of our sponsor, Mr. LeRoy Jefferys. The class of thirty-two members included: Loren Paul Anderson, Jr., Dorothy Barcroft, Anna Bell Brock, Forrest Cloonan, Hilma Cochran, Wanda Dever, Lee Dilley, Jean Hall, Gary Kershner, Eugene Kidd, Alice Landis, Letcher Landis, Jack McCoy, William McCoy, Hymon McMillion, Bernice Pyles, Barbara Rasmus, Delores Roberts, Hallie Roberts, Mary Frances Rose, Ruth Rudd, Betty Jean Scott, Betty Mae Scott, Genevieve Sharp, Arberta Shields, Ella Jo Shue, Dora Lee Simmons, Larry Stark, Thelma Totten, Delano Walker, Thomas Walker, and Gay Wooddell.

The officers of the Freshman Class were: Dora Lee Simmons, President; Alice Landis, Vice-President; Thomas Walker, Secretary and Treasurer. Bernice Pyles and Dorothy Barcroft were elected our class cheer leaders and this title they held throughout our four years together.

We were given our Freshman-Sophomore Party after having dressed in burlap sacks for three days.

On May 24 we held our class picnic at Watoga State Park.

Returning as Sophomores in the fall of 1949 our class sponsor was Mrs. Thelma Weber. We had lost Hilma Cochran, Eugene Kidd, Letcher Landis, Delores Roberts, Betty Jean Scott, Larry Stark, and Delano Walker, but we gained three new members: Edna Rose, Robert Shannon, and Anita Simmons. Our class now numbered twenty-eight members.

Our class officers were: Dora Lee Simmons, President; Barbara Rasmus, Vice-President; and Dorothy Barcroft, Secretary and Treasurer.

On November 17, we Sophomores entertained the Freshman Class with an initiation party in the gymnasium.

The class spent their picnic day, May 22, at the Federal Prison Camp.

Arriving back in school in the year of 1950 we were known as the "Jolly Juniors." Having lost Lee Dilley, Hallie Roberts, Betty Mae Scott, and Gay Wooddell, we now had twenty-six members including Betty Talbert, who had moved here from Richwood, and Hilma Cochran who had moved back from Rainelle.

Officers of the class were: Thomas Walker, President; Loren Paul Anderson, Jr., Vice-President; Alice Landis, Secretary; and Dorothy Barcroft, Treasurer.

Again in our Junior year we had Mrs. Weber as our class sponsor. Under her leadership we gave our play, "Hobgoblin House," on Friday, December 8.

In the month of October we lost a member of our class, Betty Talbert, who moved back to Richwood.

Edna Rose became Mrs. Robert Shannon.

The girls' basketball team surprised the school by defeating the other class teams and winning the class basketball tournament.

Our class rings arrived on February 29, 1951.

On May 7, the first Junior-Senior Banquet was given to the Seniors by our class. This was done in Western Style and served by the Sophomore Home Economics girls who wore western outfits. A dance in the gymnasium was held afterwards.

Droop Mountain State Park was the location for our picnic in 1951.

At last we had entered our fourth year as Seniors! Our class now numbered twenty-one. Loren Paul Anderson, Jr., had moved to Oklahoma, Edna and Robert had quit school, Anita Simmons decided to change her name to Mrs. Zelden Rose, and Thelma Totten became Mrs. Johnnie Mullins.

Thomas Walker held office as President; Bernice Pyles, Vice-President; Alice Landis, Secretary; Wanda Dever, Treasurer; and Bradley Cutlip, Bernice Pyles, Barbara Rasmus, and Dora Lee Simmons were on the Finance Committee.

In the month of November Jean Hall married Gail Cook and quit school.

The class play is to be given Thursday, May 8, the Sermon on Sunday, May 18, and the graduation exercises will be held Thursday, May 22.

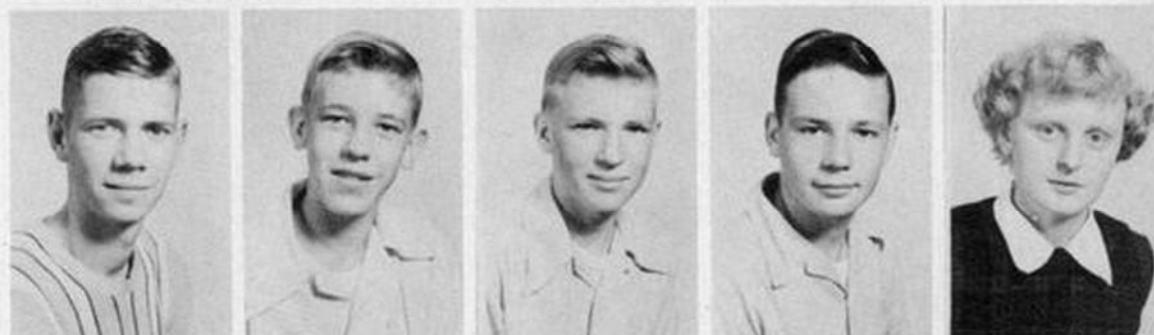

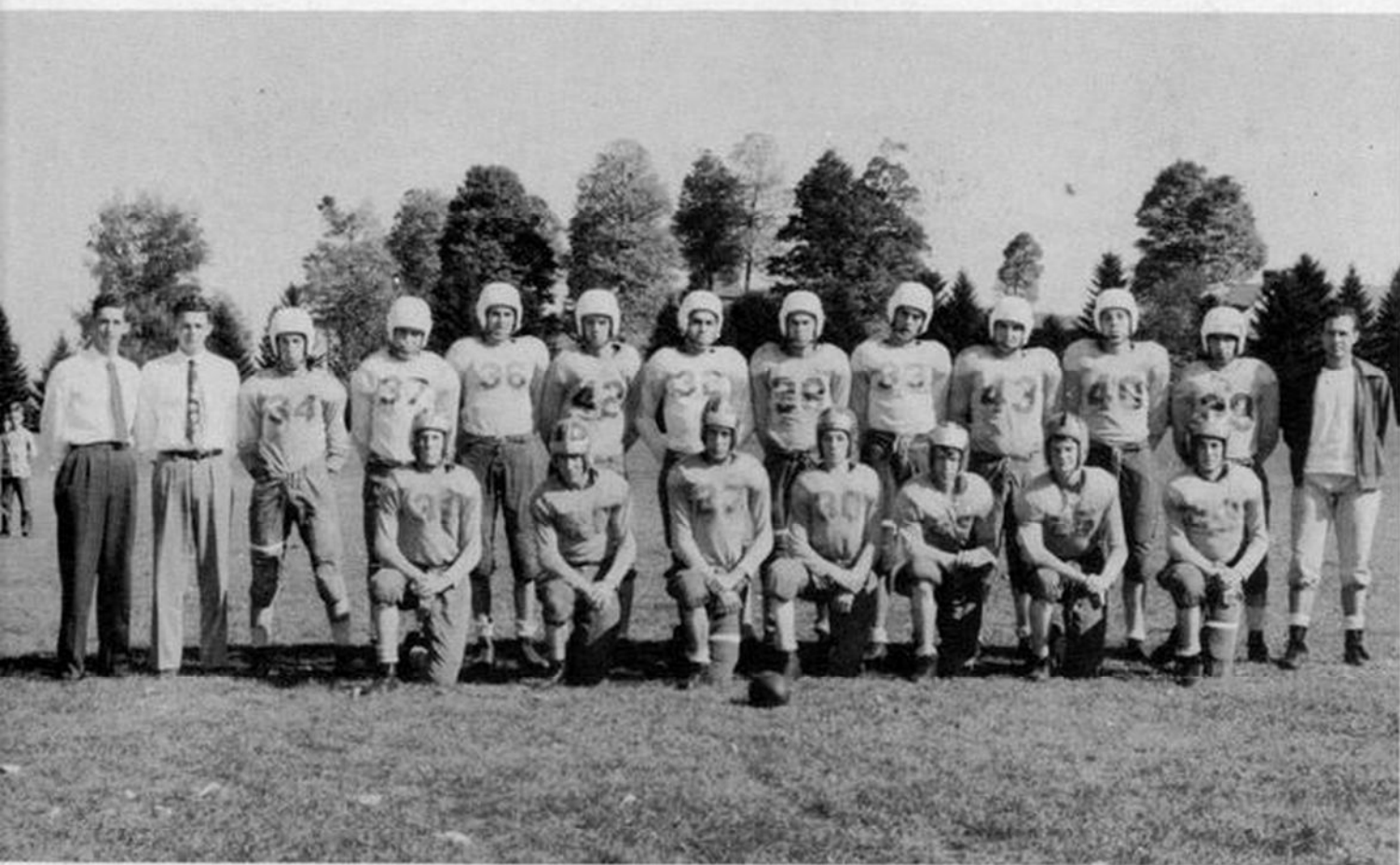

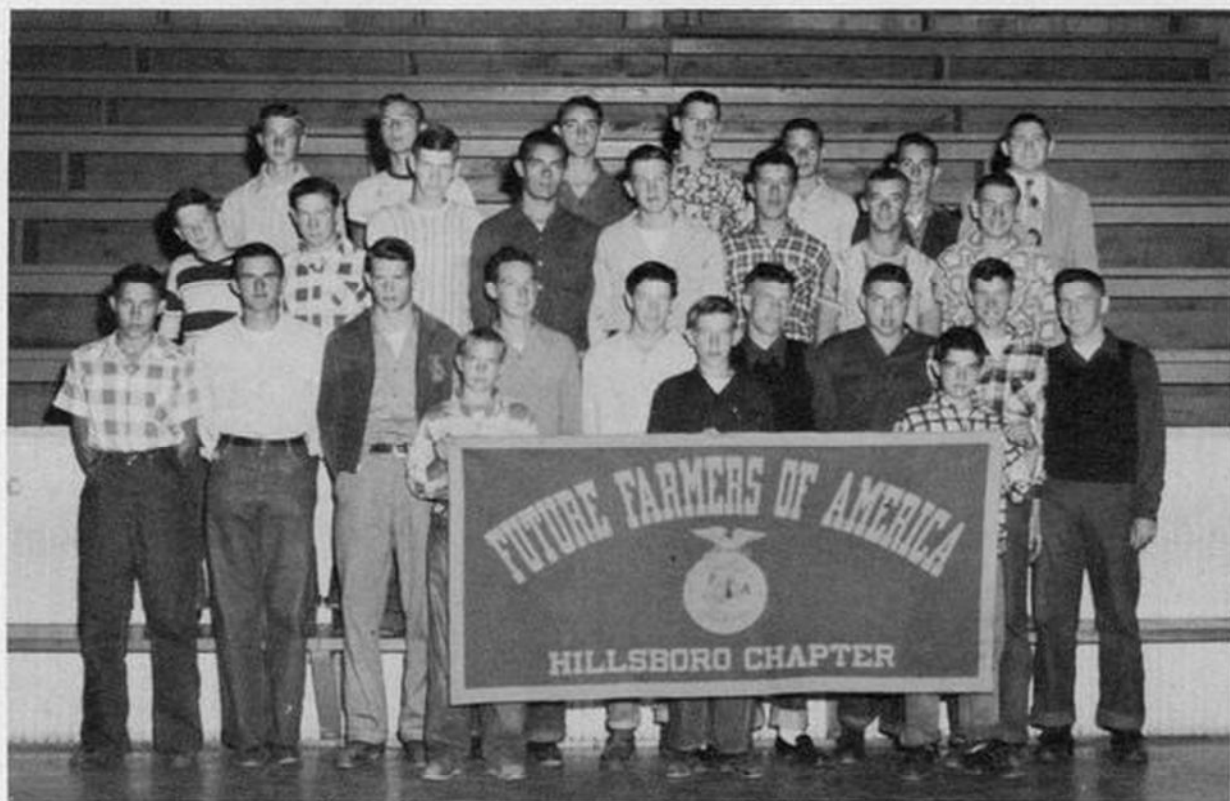
