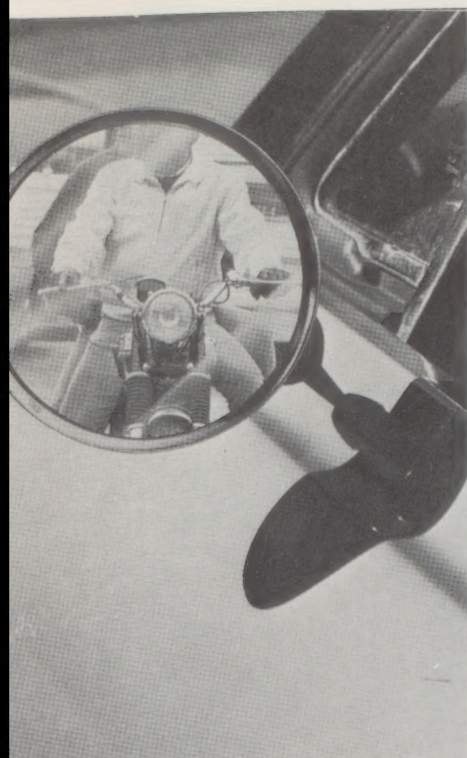


## Reflections . . .

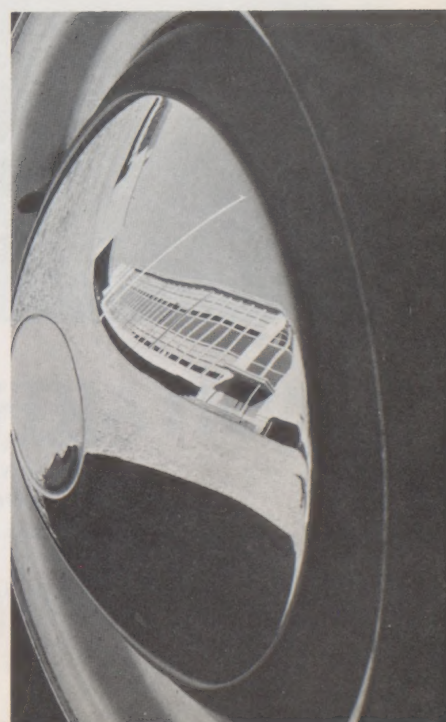

## *Dedication*

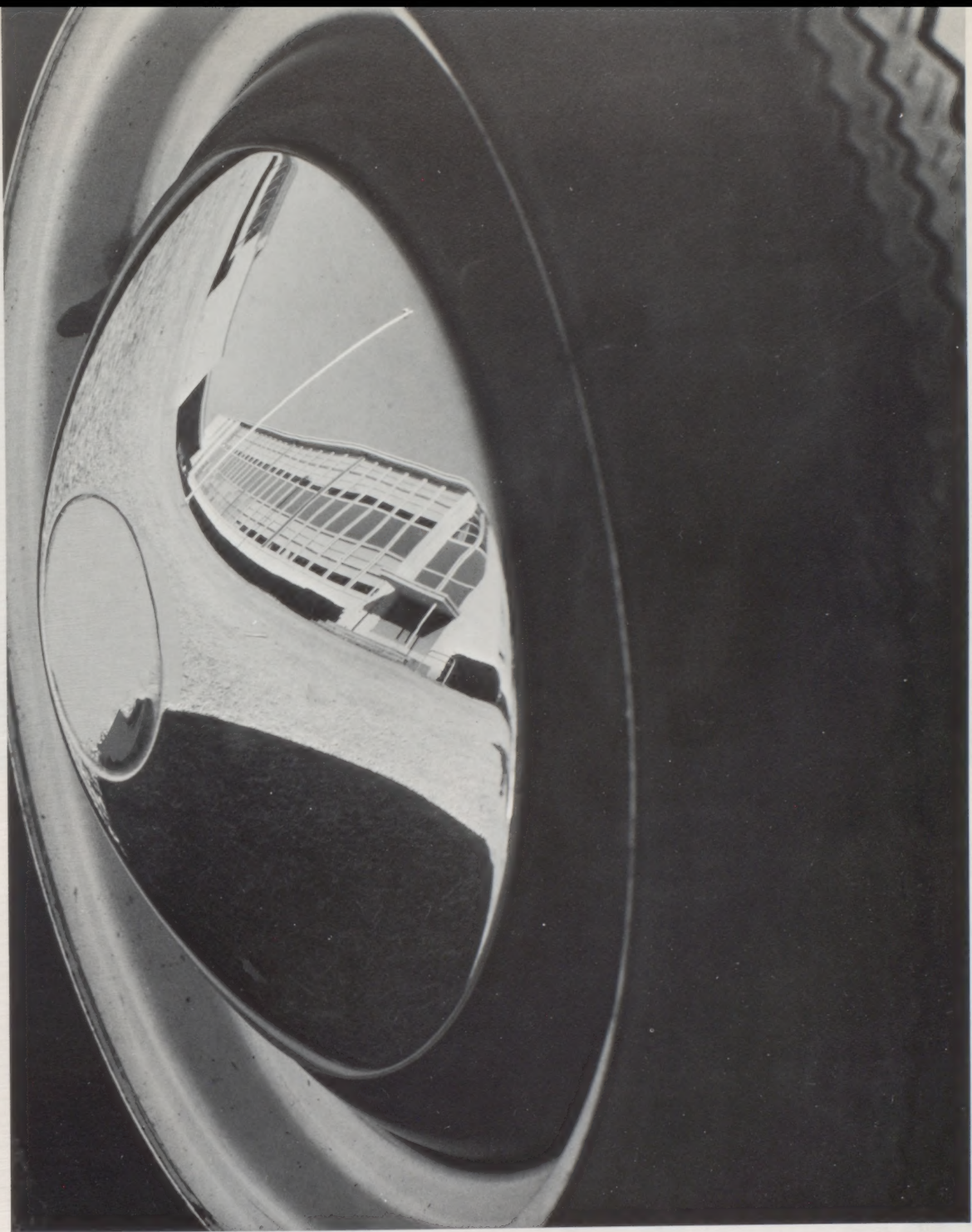


The 1968-1969 Clintonia Staff and the Senior Class take great pride in dedicating the yearbook to Mr. Austin.

Mr. Harden attended Eastern Illinois where he earned his B. A.. He has also attended I. S. U. He has taught at Clinton for thirteen years.

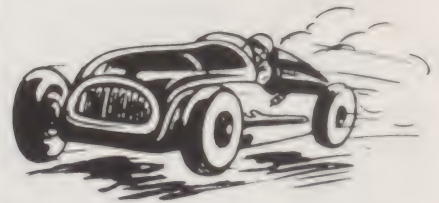
MR. TOM HALL
