MR. GEORGE WILLIAMS






The Mathematics Department offers six courses. They are General Math, Algebra I, Geometry A., Plane Geometry, Algebra II, Trigonometry, and Math IV.

He attended U. of I. and Olivet College in Kankakee. He has a B.S. of Arts from Illinois State. This is his first year at Clinton High.




Mrs. Linder gained her B. A. at Millikin University and I.S.U. She has taught 6 years in Greenville, Ill. and 16 in Clinton.

Mrs. Helm attended Illinois Wesleyan University and has her B. M.E. She has taught at C.C.H.S. for 12 years.






MR. JOSEPH STONE


MRS. SHARON SIMMONS
